## School Health Advisory Council Meeting

## Thursday, November 1, 2012

## Minutes

The second SHAC meeting of the 2012-13 school year was held on Thursday, November 1, 2012 from 12:00 pm – 1:00 pm. Those in attendance were: Debra Velasco, Velma Reason, Bonnie Schendel, Tammy Russell, Julie Maupin, Roslyn Molland, Ronnie Thomas, Traci Younts, and Cindy Clendennen.

Items on the agenda included a review of the October 18<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes (approved) and a presentation by Traci Younts, ACE Director.

Mrs. Younts described activities that are provided for all students who attend the ACE program at their home campus. Activities include academic programs such as tutorials, physical activities such as games and sports, and social activities such as cooking. According to Mrs. Younts enrollment is high at each campus site and it appears Beeville ISD will reach enrollment goals this school year.

Along with a student component, the grant requires a parental support component where guest speakers are scheduled to provide training to parents. Attendance has been low but all site directors continue to reinforce the importance of parental involvement.

Other items for discussion included future dates of the remaining meetings to be held February 7<sup>th</sup>, and April 4<sup>th</sup>. With the implementation of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, federal rules on meal standards have been reviewed and revised. The Act also addresses district wellness policies, with the intent of strengthening those policies. Once standards are set and guidelines are posted, the SHAC will be charged with revising the BISD Wellness policy. Final regulations are scheduled to be released in the fall of 2013 but the SHAC may begin review of the current policy at the next two meetings.
