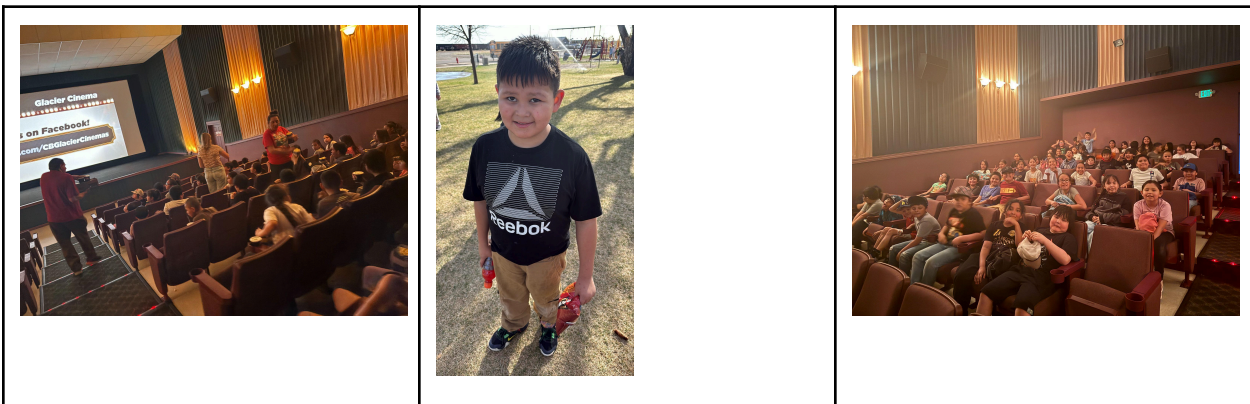

Coaches Corner

For the month of May there was a Parent Teacher Conference, The teachers were given PD bridging to the online Benchmark ELA Weekly assessment. Teachers were supported in how to assign the test and coaches showed students how to navigate through the assessment using the online tools. We continue to support teachers in the classroom with the online assessment and exploration of the tools.

We are currently piloting IXL Language Arts. The diagnostic assessment gives teachers instant feedback for each student. Students practice standards strands within the IXL platform.

Teachers meet collaboratively ever three weeks to plan/prep math lessons for whole group and small group instruction. This has been noticed to be very effective for team planning.
