Mr. Underwood,

Last Tuesday the eighth after the storms came through Dell Goodwin and myself surveyed the district facilities and found the following.

Gilbert Intermediate annex had lost a portion of the roof allowing water damage in classrooms two and four. These rooms are used for band and also had most of the band instruments located in these two classrooms. There was little damage to the instruments. The piano did get a significant amount of water in and on it. The stereo that is used for their class was damaged. As far as the building itself, the ceiling tile will all have to be changed as well as the insulation above the ceiling tile in both classrooms. We will possibly have to repaint the both rooms and install new cove base in both rooms. We removed the base and drilled holes in the walls to allow for the walls to dry on the inside. I had a company from the metroplex temporarily patch the roof on the same day preventing any further damage. We had Steamatic come in and cleanup and dry what they could to remove the water.

Athletics had some damage as well. The baseball field lost a lot of the wind screen on the outfield fence. Also the lower portion of the scoreboard which advertises the companies that gave donations for the sign was damaged beyond repair. the scoreboard itself is ok. At Lem Brock there was some fence damage along with damage to the new soccer shelters.

On Monday there was numerous window damage found on Central and Gilbert campuses. The company has been notified and has been here to measure for the replacements.

TASB insurance was notified on Tuesday and Jeff Miller with Engle Martin was here Thursday to walk and assess the damages.

At this time this is all that has been found. There was an amount of debris found at Hook on the grounds and on top of the building but it all came from off campus locations and no damage was found on that building. The Administration building had some shingles off but we repaired that on the day of the storm.
