Low Attendance Days

Districts or campuses can request a waiver to excuse any instructional days from ADA and FSP funding calculations that have attendance at least 10 percentage points below the last school year's overall average attendance due to inclement weather, health, or safety-related issues.

Our 2016-2017 Summer PEIMS Submission ADA was 94.1%. We are requesting permission to submit waivers to TEA for the following four days.

December 8, 2017-District Waiver

- Attendance 82.37%
 - Safety issue with road closures and weather conditions the night before due to snow.

January 19, 2018-Individual Campus Waivers

- Dwight 84.07%
- Five Palms 83.93%
- Carrillo 83.08%
 - All three experienced safety issues due to hazardous road conditions because of the school closures the day before due ice on the road.

February 16, 2018-Individual Campus Waiver

- South San High School- 80.11%
 - Students were kept home by parents for safety concerns due to a social media post that caused concern

April 20, 2018-Individual Campus Waiver

- South San High School- 82.01%
 - Students did not attend school or students in attendance walked out of class due to a student-organized protest day
