FEEDBACK

- *Grade level consultants solicit informal feedback most weeks from teachers*
 - *Formal feedback was gathered during grade level meetings on SIP days*
 - *Grade level consultants meet regularly with Anne Marie and Christie*
 - *Students were formally surveyed in Spring of 2024 and in Fall of 2024*
 - *Met with Eric's Principal's Student Advisory in December of 2024*
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Student Feedback Indicates:

- Differentiated lessons are more grade level specific and the topics are more appealing to students
- Students overwhelmingly feel comfortable reaching out to their LT teacher
- The majority of students feel comfortable sharing during LT
