

How do we know its working?

PBIS Principles

- Behaving is a skill that is taught and learned
- Don't assume kids know how to behave the way we want them to
- It is our responsibility to teach and reinforce behavior in the same way we teach any other skill
- Setting specific is the best approach
- We want to provide specific feedback and correction (vs. general praise), just like when teaching any other skill
- Keep the tone about learning, reinforce immediate corrections vs. punishing the original error
- By broadly and regularly acknowledging students who are doing the right thing, more students will want to do the right thing
- Bucks, tickets, thumbs up, points, etc.
- Review with kids at every transition until the system is smooth then review intermittently (no less than once a month, and at every break)
- OK to review daily and always for groups who need it
