#### **Attention Parents!!**

Students will be bringing home enrollment packets the first day of school. Enclosed in the packets you will find all the necessary paperwork to enroll your student for the 2009-2010 school year. - PINK Enrollment Form: ALL STUDENTS must have updated enrollment information. This form includes all emergency information and contacts. Please update all information, sign and <u>return to school the next day.</u>
   It is important to keep this information updated through out the school year. If you have any changes please let Mindi in the office know.
- Three Rivers School District Network Agreement: This is an agreement for you and your student to read and sign stating his/her agreement to follow the district's Electronic Communications System policy and administrative regulation. This agreement requires your signature.
- Family Advocate Services: If your family is in need of any of our provided services, please fill out this form and return to school.
- Parents Request for Giving Medication: If your child is required to receive any medication (prescription or over the counter) while at school please provide the necessary information on the form and return to school. (Medication must be in the original container)
- Medical Insurance Enrollment Form: If you would like to enroll your student in the Student Health Care plan please fill out the enclosed forms and return to the office.

Positive Behavior Support (P.B.S.), promotes appropriate behaviors by teaching, reinforcing, re-teaching, celebrating, and rewarding positive behaviors.

Williams Elementary School is striving to improve behavior by teaching appropriate behavior in situations that arise at school and in every area of the school.

During the first days of school teachers brainstorm with students and ask them how they should behave in specific areas of the school, such as the gym, playground, cafeteria, etc. We then practice the appropriate behavior with the students. #### **SAFETY REMINDERS**

Now that children are returning back to school, please observe all safety signs, crosswalks, and speed limits within the school zones and while following school buses.

Children are entering and exiting buses, walking or riding bikes to school, and being picked up or dropped off daily. Often times children still use the playground or track after normal school hours. Be aware at all times and observe the speed limits. Please remind your child

to follow all safety rules while riding to and from school on the school bus.

#### CHANGING BUS ARRANGEMENTS

At any time if your child is going to ride a different bus, or go home with another student, you must send a signed note to the school office with your child in the morning. If emergencies arise during school hours and you must change your child's plans please call Mindi in the office at 846-7224. Students will not be allowed to call home during school hours to make play arrangements with other students.
