We are excited to announce David Stubbs as our recommendation for Aledo High School's Assistant Principal.

We had seventy-one candidates apply for this position; we had forty-seven applicants who met the minimum and preferred requirements that include a Master's degree, the appropriate administrator certification, and a minimum of three years as a classroom teacher. From this pool of forty-seven applicants, seventeen were given a phone interview screener, five of which were internal candidates. From this pool, the committee selected twelve individuals who were invited for a formal interview that consisted of a three person interview team, Lynn McKinney, Denise Dugger and Kathy Allen. We conducted full reference checks on the applicants selected for the team interview.

- A Master of Education Administration from Texas Wesleyan University

- Began his teaching career in Castleberry ISD where he spent six years as a history teacher and coach.
