In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the second grading cycle (October 1 – November 2).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 24 days (October 01 – November 02).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 2 is 96.52%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for EE 92.43 % followed by 12 grade 94.40%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade, 97.38 followed by 3rd grade, 97.27%.
- Overall attendance decreased .92 of a point from cycle 1.
