

Consideration of City of Denton Police Department Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

(December 14, 2010)

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the MOU between the Denton Independent School District and the City of Denton Police Department (DPD). This MOU establishes and delineates the mission of the School Resource Officer Program (SRO Program) as a joint cooperative effort.

In pursuit of excellence, the district will provide support services and promote health, wellness and safety for students and families.

DISD agrees at a future date to expand this agreement to include Calhoun Middle School, McMath Middle School, and Strickland Middle School.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Effective November 1, 2010, the DISD agrees to reimburse the City of Denton at a rate of fifty (50) percent of the actual annual salary and benefits of the SRO's assigned to the following campuses: Denton High School / Ryan High School / and Guyer High School. DPD will invoice the DISD quarterly for all monies owed and will submit appropriate payroll documentation with the invoice.

Passage will continue to promote a safe environment for DISD students.
