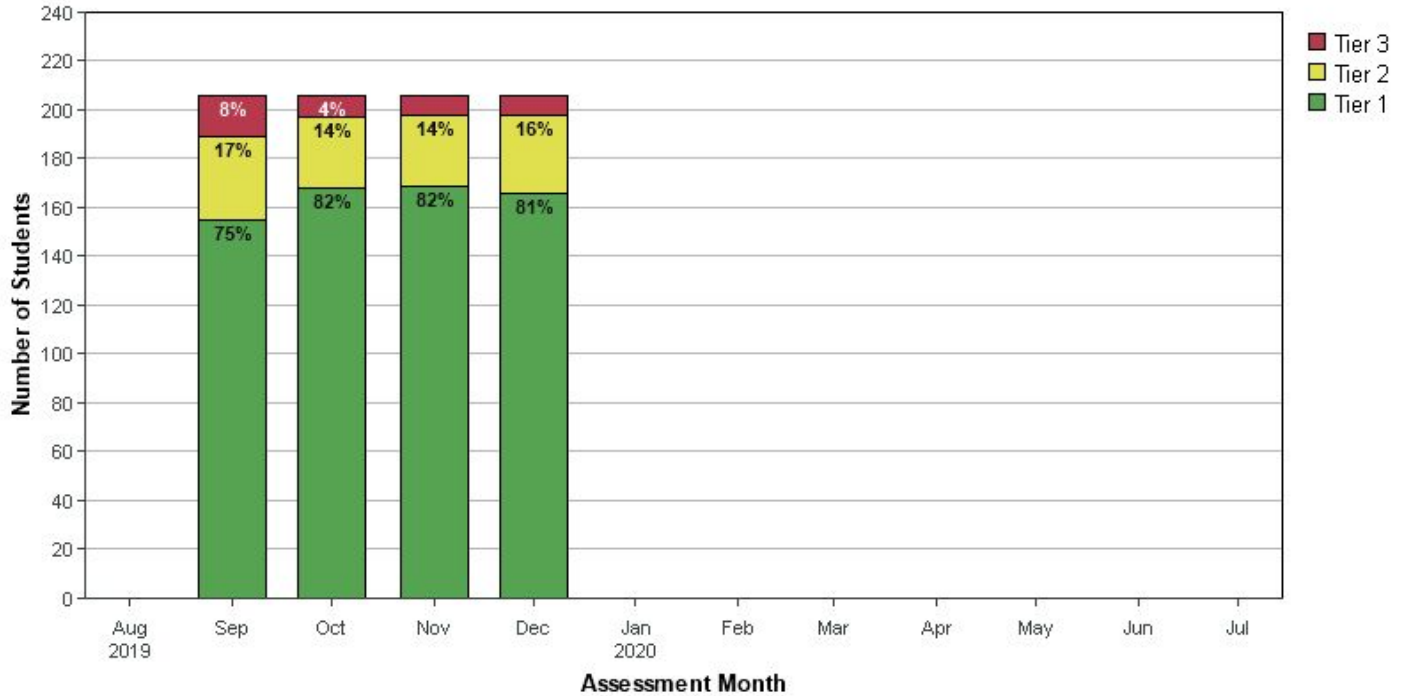

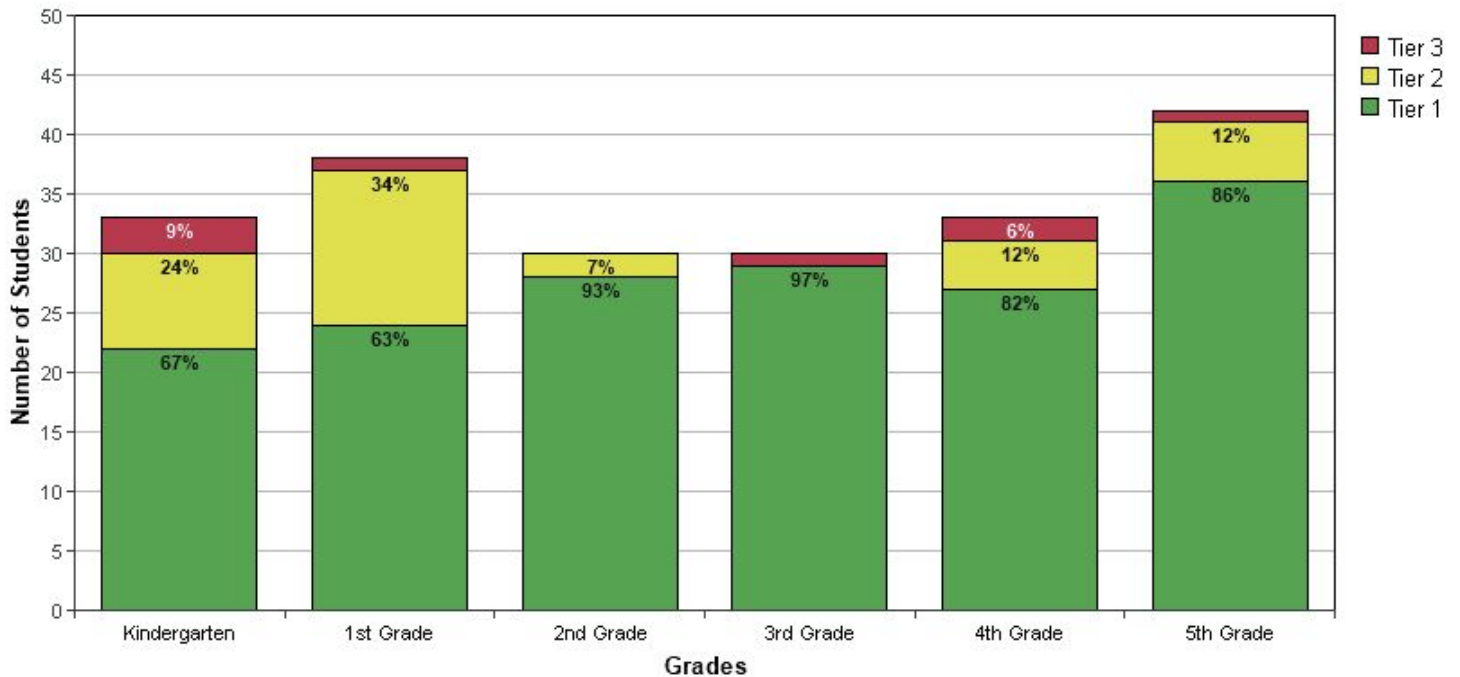
All Grades - Overall Reading

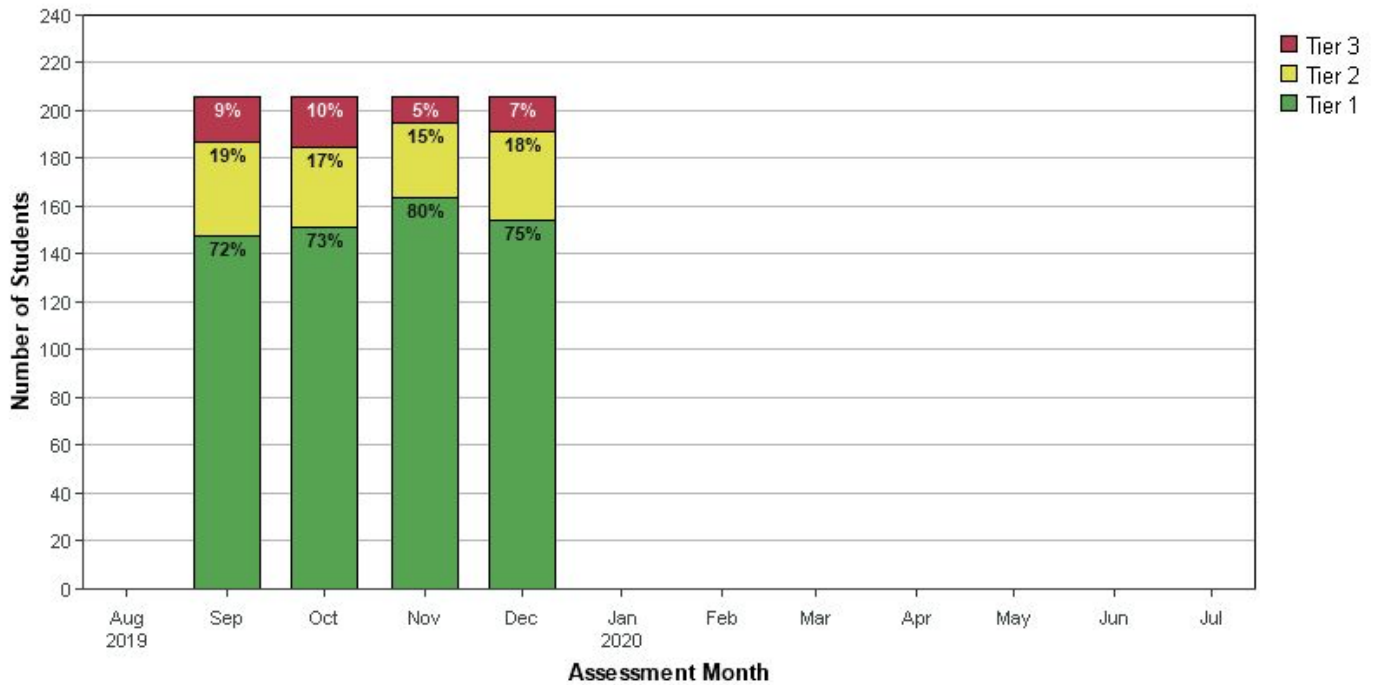


December Tier Movement for Istation Benchmarking- Math
