Version 1:

- Staff professional development days are scheduled on election days (November 3, February 16, April 6)
 - Allows for consistent professional development throughout the year.
- Includes October 30, Fall Break, as a non-work day.
- Three days off for Thanksgiving Break.
- Two full weeks for Winter Break.
- Extended Memorial Day Weekend.

Version 2:

- Staff professional development days are scheduled on election days (November 3, February 16, April 6)
 - Allows for consistent professional development throughout the year.
- Does not include October 30 as a non-work day.
- Full week off for students (one PD day for staff) for Thanksgiving Break.
- Two full weeks for Winter Break.
- Regular Memorial Day Weekend.

We sent the calendar survey to parents and staff separately to ensure that we gathered clear, specific feedback from each group based on their unique perspectives and needs.


Parents and staff experience the school calendar differently, parents focus on family scheduling and childcare, while staff consider instructional planning and workload.


Which calendar (version 1, version 2) do you prefer for the 2026-27 school year?

THE VOICE FEEDBACK - VERSION 1

Version 1 - Pros

- Day off before Halloween
- Balanced November schedule that makes up for fewer breaks in Sept./Oct.
- Two full weeks off for winter break
- Spring break timing with April PD Days allows for nice student breaks
- Overall pacing is steady, with exam and midterm timing fitting well

Version 1 - Cons

- Long stretch from Sept.-Oct. with no days off—difficult for students and teachers
- Fall break is minimal, with teachers receiving only one day off
- Thanksgiving break is not a full week
- Not having the day after Easter off (March 29)

THE VOICE FEEDBACK - VERSION 2

Version 2 - Pros

- Full week off for Thanksgiving
- Two full weeks off for winter break
- January exam week is well-structured
- Professional development days teachers
- At least one day off in May, easing the long spring stretch

<u>Version 2 - Cons</u>

- Long stretch from Sept.-Oct. with no days off—difficult for students and teachers
- No Fall Break Day
