

**Crosby-Ironton School Board
Activities Committee Meeting Notes
From meeting held October 5, 2016 5:30 p.m.**

NOTES

1. Review fall participation numbers

Sports totals are down from 206 participants to 185 participants.

2. Compare fall participation numbers to fall participation numbers from previous years

Choir numbers are up from 179 last year to 210 students this year.

No data available for band yet.

3. Review participation fees

The committee is not recommending any changes at this time.

- a. Scholarship requests

25 kids applied for and were awarded scholarships to participate in activities. These scholarships are paid for by the MSHL Operations Opportunity Grant.

4. Review uniform rotation schedule

This topic was tabled until a current schedule could be located and will be discussed the next time the committee meets.

5. Review uniform purchase expectations regarding school colors

This topic was tabled and will be discussed in conjunction with the topic of uniform rotation the next time the committee meets.

6. Discuss C-I logo, because there are several different ones currently being used.

The A.D. introduced the concept of a new C-I logo design and a new banner image design. The committee ultimately supported the concept contingent that the students be the major driving force behind the creation of a potential new design. A word of caution was conveyed that the school board would have to review and approve any proposed changes with the C-I logo.

7. Update on score table and advertising on the screen.

A new score table with a t.v. monitor will be up and running by mid-November in the Ranger gym.

8. Program evaluation

The committee spoke at length about the board's expectation with program evaluation. The expectation is that one component of a healthy program is a good feeder program. The district should have strong elementary student participation and skill development at the younger ages. The evaluation of a program should be identified as healthy or unhealthy. If a program is deemed unhealthy, the A.D. needs to communicate to the board the facets of the program that contribute to the unhealthy program and the action steps the district has taken or is taking to remedy toward a healthy program.

The winter sports staff is in place. The coaching staff have been hired.
