2025 Evacuation Drill Cameron High School October 9, 2025

Summary of Drill:

On Thursday, October 9, 2025, Cameron High School joined Cameron Middle School and conducted an Emergency Action Drill which involved an evacuation of the building and a reunification at the bus garage. Staff was aware, and communication was emailed to families the day before. Special Needs students were allowed to opt out of the drill and stay home. Deputy Andy Krahenbuhl was involved in the evacuation, and Cameron Chief of Police Tony Engel was present and monitored traffic during the drill.

We began the drill with an announcement over the PA system at approximately 10:00 am. Students and teachers were instructed to exit the building using the fire exits and travel to the bus garage with their classes. Once there, they split into their Homerooms and lined up by grade level.

I walked the school to make sure everyone was out of the building. I then walked to the bus garage. Once in the bus garage, teachers got their attendance sheets from Megan and Sally and attendance was taken. All students were accounted for. We then practiced locating a student in the hypothetical situation of a parent arriving to transport their child home. We went through the hard copy of student information to randomly select a parent.

After all students were accounted for, I made a short announcement instructing students and staff to return to the building and go to 3rd Period.

Successful Highlights:

- 1. Students traveled in an organized fashion, and all classrooms were accounted for.
- 2. Students maintained proper behavior at the bus garage.
- 3. Staff were professional and maintained the appropriate level of concern.

Areas of Improvement for Next Drill:

- 1. Determine the best rooms/teachers to have radios for emergency situations. Those near exits should be considered a priority.
- 2. Make sure teachers know to take attendance on provided rosters rather than handwriting names.
- 3. Use professional development time to reinforce Emergency Action Plan procedures.
- 4. Assemble the Emergency Action Plan team to review all crisis situations.
