Agenda Item Title: Constraint Progress Monitoring: Rigorous Curriculum

Description: The Board of Managers will receive a progress monitoring update aligned to the District's Constraint 1: Rigorous Curriculum. This update provides an overview of current progress toward ensuring that core academic subjects utilize High-Quality Instructional Materials (HQIM) in daily instruction, and increasing the fidelity of implementation of (HQIM) in daily instruction, as measured through walkthroughs.

Constraint 1 includes the following progress measures:

- **1.1:** SSAISD will ensure that core academic subjects utilize High-Quality Instructional Materials (HQIM) in daily instruction, increasing from an unknown baseline in the 2024–2025 school year to 95% implementation by June 2026.
- **1.2:** SSAISD will increase the fidelity of implementation of High-Quality Instructional Materials (HQIM) in daily instruction, as measured through walkthroughs focused on mastery of implementation, from 25% in September 2025 to 75% by June 2026.

The presentation will highlight current performance data, progress toward each constraint measure, and trends over time. These data will be reviewed to enable the Board to monitor implementation fidelity, assess progress toward established goals, and identify areas of strength and opportunities for continued improvement.

This update supports the Board's governance responsibility to monitor progress toward defined constraints, ensure accountability for district priorities, and maintain alignment between educator support systems and improved student outcomes.

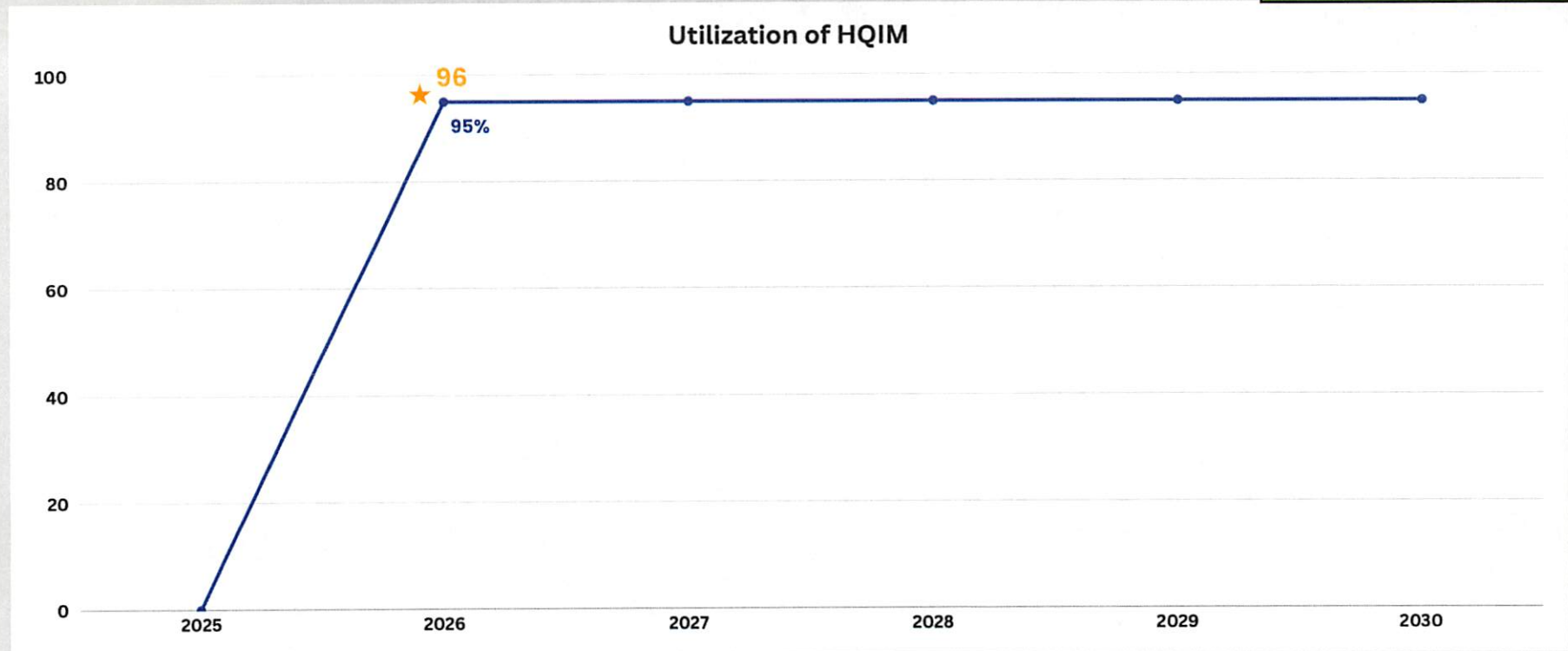

- Facilitate professional learning that will emphasize effective lesson internalization, differentiation, and student engagement to maximize the impact of HQIM on student outcomes.

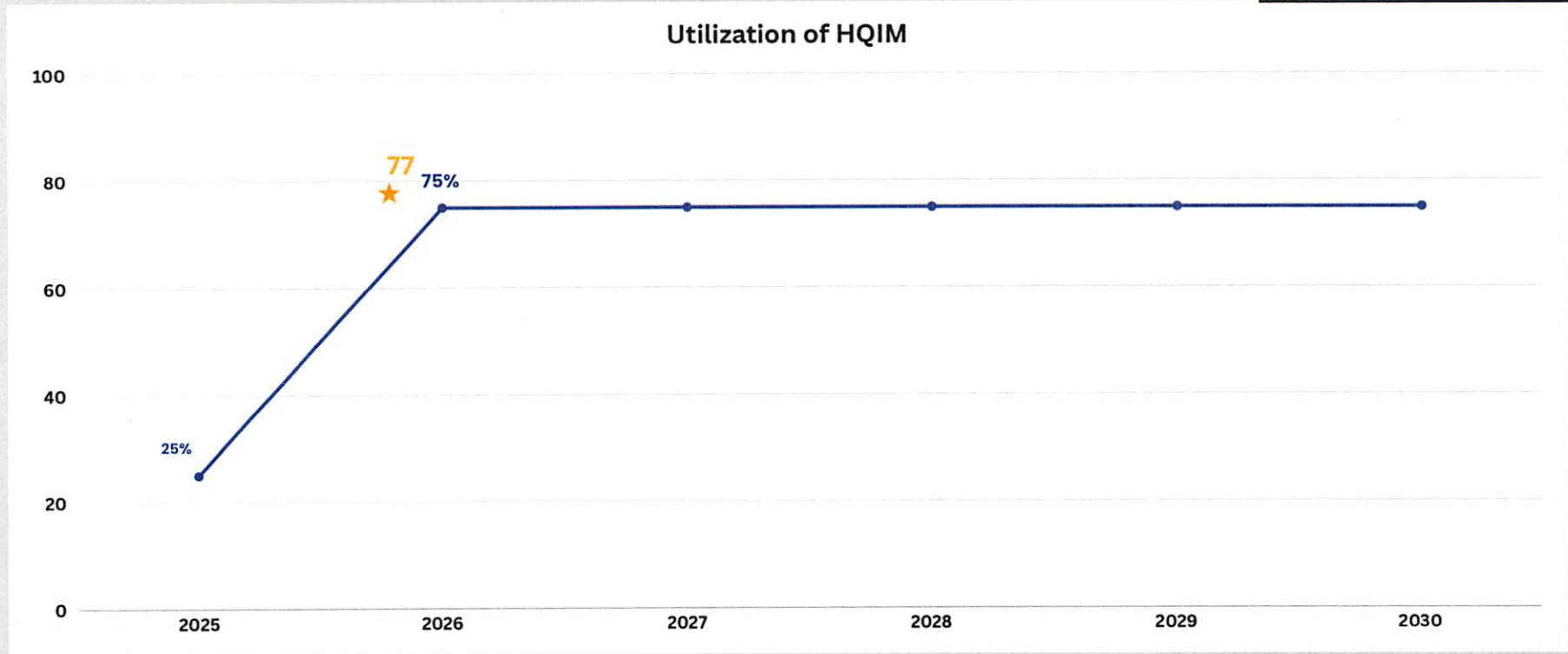
