





### Get Tested:



Once a year if sexually active



Every 3-6 months if having unprotected sex







### The Most Effective Way to Avoid STIs = Abstinence

- \*Abstinence" means not doing something.
- Sexual abstinence means not having sex.
- It is also called:
  - Delaying sex
  - Waiting
- Choosing not to have sex

Abstinence from sex prevents pregnancy and STIs.

### **Reasons People Abstain from Sex**

- Focus on classes and education goals
- Get to know each other better before sex
- Avoid pregnancy
- Avoid STIs
  - Proud they can say no

- Partner not willing
- Want to be in love first
- Feel like they are not ready or too young
- Haven't met the right
- person yet
- Want to avoid getting hurt Just don't want to

### **Ways to Prevent HIV Transmission**

- Wait to have sex (anal, oral, vaginal).
- Use condoms or another latex barrier.
- Don't inject drugs or share needles.
  - Get tested before deciding to have sex.




### **STI Treatments and Terms**

Many safe and effective medications help people with HIV:

- Antibiotics:
  - These cure STIs caused by bacteria and some parasites
- Antiviral drugs:

These reduce the effects of herpes (HSV) and HIV.







### **HIV Treatments and Terms**

Many safe and effective medications help people with HIV:

- live healthy, long lives, and
- reduce the chances of passing HIV to others.

### Terms to know:

- Treatment As Prevention (TasP)
- Antiretroviral Therapy (ART)
  - Undetectable equals Untransmittable (U = U)



**U = U | Undetectable = Untransmittable**
