Correspondence

- We have not received any significant correspondence this month.

Information/Updates

- **Minico Hitting Facility Update** – I met with Jared Price last week and he indicated that with only a little painting to do they will be able to get the turf down. Progress has slowed down recently because of play-offs.
- **Food Service Building Remodel** – Waiting on final drawings to proceed with putting this out to bid.
- **Hawk's Landing East Minico Irrigation Pipe** – We have recorded the change in the easement with the County and will be sending the associated bills to the developer for reimbursement.
- **Negotiations** – The Negotiations Team has met weekly since the 28th of March. We have made progress on several different issues though there have been some difficulties in coming to agreement in some areas recently.

I have met with many teachers in their classrooms at Heyburn Elementary and a number of different administrators throughout the District.

It was very informative and I felt good that we had already addressed a number of the areas that were mentioned (staff social media use, hiring/personnel procedures, bond elections). I met with the members of the **Leadership Premium Committee** on April 26th. They are scheduled to meet again with their input from their buildings on the 11th. Revisions to the list of stipends will be presented to the Board in June.

She indicated that we would be able to have their support for one more year. They provide a person to assist the Minico and East Minico administrators' in improving instruction.
