<p>Objective #1.1 Improve English Proficiency</p>	<p>We finished the started the second unit in the OWLS curriculum (Family.) Each week we focused on a different number, letter, emotion, color, and 6 concept words. We are currently on the 3<sup>rd</sup> week in the unit. We have two times during the day that we have the students in small groups. We placed the students in groups based on what tier they are in. Bi-weekly on Fridays, I pull the students aside to test them on what we focused on that week.</p>
<p>Objective #1.2 Improve progress in learning English</p>	<p>On October 4<sup>th</sup> 2018, every student enrolled at the time in the program was developmentally pre-screened by Bear paw co-op. The majority of the students were reported to be at age level, or advanced.</p> <p>By the end of the year, I want the majority of the students to be in the benchmark tier and ready for Kindergarten.</p> <p>I have been scaffolding learning objectives throughout the week. I have been using multiple different ways to teach materials. I am assessing students' knowledge every two weeks. I plan on using my data to direct my instruction.</p> <p>We have sent Friday homework folders each week with additional materials to aid learning. Every week, I have been sending home materials related to the letters we are working on. Next week, I will send home the alphabet books that are a part of our curriculum. I will also be sending home number and letter flash cards.</p>
<p>Objective #1.3 Increase proficiency attainment</p>	<p>I am using my data to keep my students that are proficient according to the OWLS curriculum to be advanced by the end of pre-</p>

	<p>K. I will be assessing students bi-weekly and quarterly to track their attainment.</p> <p>Currently, we are still waiting for our Ipad cases so we can screen students using Ipad with Istation. (Rocky Boy Schools new DIBELS assessment.) Assessments should be complete by the end of the month, depending on when cases arrive.</p>
