1. Give a brief narrative description of the waiver being requested.

The Keller Independent School District is requesting a waiver to allow its alternative education school of choice campus (New Direction Learning Center) to take attendance at flexible hours. The waiver allows the district to claim Average Daily Attendance (ADA) for students who would normally miss the attendance period due to family or work-related issues.

2. Does the district or campus plan reflect the need for this waiver? If yes what is the specific objective impacted by the wavier?

Yes. The waiver addresses both the district and campus plans. The objective is to expand and improve services to all students who are at-risk of dropping out of school and to increase the percentage of student attendance.

 Cite the Texas Education Code or the Texas Administration Code that the district or campus wishes to waive?

A student must be enrolled for at least two hours to be considered in membership for half day, and for at least four hours to be considered in membership for one full day. 19 TAC 129.21(h)

4. Describe the plan to be implemented, if the waiver is granted.

The waiver will allow the alternative education school of choice campus (New Direction Learning Center) to take attendance at flexible hours. Student attendance will be calculated on a daily basis. Daily time cards will be used to track the attendance of students, in addition to roll being taken each class period.

5. How will granting this waiver help achieve the districts or campus's objective?

The waiver will enhance the educational services provided to our at-risk student population. Students, who are unable to attend school daily during predetermined fixed hours, will have the flexibility to attend at variable times within the school day.

 Please explain how the school district or campus will evaluate the impact of the waiver toward meeting the district or campus's goals.

Students' attendance and course completion will be used to measure the impact the waiver will have on student achievement.
