> **Battle of the Books** (Action Item)

NSBSD Policy Manual:

BP 3290, Gifts, Grants and Bequests: The School Board greatly appreciates the support of community members and may accept suitable donations on behalf of the district. To be acceptable, a gift, grant or bequest should satisfy the following criteria:

- 1. Not begin a program that the Broad would be unwilling to continue when the donated funds are exhausted:
- 2. Not entail undesirable or hidden costs, such as additional staff workload;
- 3. Place no restrictions on the school program;
- 4. Not be inappropriate or harmful to the best education of students;
- 5. Not imply endorsement of any business or product;
- 6. Not conflict with any provision of the board policy or public law;
- 7. Have a purpose consistent with those of the district.

Issue Summary:

The Arctic Slope Telephone Association Cooperative (ASTAC) is donating \$15,000, an annual contribution, to support the Battle of the Books program which covers the cost of books and supplies for every school in the District.

This contribution provides students in 3rd grade through 12th grade district-wide encouragement to read and the opportunity to become stronger readers, gain different perspectives on topics/issues, and the importance each member in a team provides.
