News & Notes:

- We hosted Prairie Fire Children's Theatre January 16th 21st to produce a musical version of "Jack and the Beanstalk". The play registration filled out and we had 72 local students ranging from Kindergarten through 11th grade participate in the play!
- Public performances were offered on Friday evening and Saturday afternoon and Friday had a paid attendance of 275 adults & students and Saturday's paid attendance came in at 250.
- The production was very well received by the students, families, and community and we look forward to having Prairie Fire return July 10th 15th when they will put on a production of "Cinderella."
- We are starting to look forward to summer programming and plan to add a couple new opportunities for adults as well as continue the weekly picnic program in addition to our usual summer activities.
