Other Items

Peter Graves, Graves Design Group presented an update on Copeland Manor School Addition regarding punch list, closeout documents and allowance change orders. The gym floor continues to be the biggest problem, third party testing company to verify quality of flooring. Landscaping, asphalt and concrete issues will be dealt with after weather improves.

Peter Graves had pre-bid meeting, 17 contractors showed up and 19 have pulled plans. We are going to extend date from March 6 to the week of March 13. Plan is to take the March Board Meeting. The school has an oil tank, preliminary investigation on Friday to determine location, removal and remediation in June. We are developing an abatement plan to remove asbestos, we are including demo of the area in the abatement contract. Finalizing everything with Fire Department, Village and Regional Office of Education.

Pam Imholz and Jon Hallmark proposal for 1:1 programming, called Access 1 to 1, Highland has enough devices to go to one to one. Every classroom has chrome books and uses google classroom. Use the application of learning to explain the how this program will further support the applications of learning. Jon and Pam did some site visits on how other middle schools are doing this. This will be a pilot program with the incoming 6th graders, it was recommended by other districts that have done this.
