THAT, the Denton Independent School District of Denton County, Texas, Grantor, in consideration of the sum of Ten and no/100 Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid by the City of Denton, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas, Grantee, an easement for the purpose of placing, constructing, operating, repairing, inspecting, rebuilding, replacing, removing, relocating and perpetually maintaining one (1) underground water meter within the following described premises situated in Denton County, Texas, to-wit:

Being a 150 square foot tract of land situated in the R. Beaumont Survey, Abstract No. 31, Denton County, Texas and being a portion of Lot 1, block A of the Final Plat of Denton High School West as recorded in Cabinet K, Page 225 of the Plat Records of Denton County, Texas. Said 150.00 square foot tract being more particularly described in the attached Exhibit A and illustrated in Exhibit B which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

FURTHER, it is agreed by Grantor that Grantee shall have the right to remove from the premises described in Exhibit A all above ground improvements and obstructions to the construction and operation of the water meter. Further, Grantee, its agents, employees, workmen and representatives shall have the right of ingress, egress and regress in, along, and upon the easement for the purpose of placing, constructing, operating, repairing, inspecting, rebuilding, replacing, removing, relocating, and perpetually maintaining the one (1) water meter. Grantor further reserves the right to construct a fence upon, over and across the easement granted herein along Grantor's boundary, and if such fence is constructed Grantee shall have the obligation of repairing or replacing the fence if in the exercise of Grantee's rights granted herein it becomes necessary for Grantee to temporarily remove the fence.
