Board Report March 2012 Ozona Middle School

- 1. Mock STAAR for all subjects was completed on March 9th. We are using data from the mocks for classroom teaching decisions, RtI sessions, and Academic Support. Students were able to simulate the four hour session and feel confident that they could finish the exam with plenty of time to check over their work and use the test taking strategies that we have been implementing during class instruction.
- 2. STAAR Testing begins for OMS on March 27th and 28th for 7th Grade Writing and 8th grade Math and Reading. We had a STAAR information night for parents on March 5th to give out information and answer parent questions about the new testing program.
- 3. We are continuing with our CIA notebooks, benchmarking and are looking ahead to next year as far as a CNA plan for our core areas. We are going to plan a vertical alignment day for ELA and social studies similar to the one for math and science for them to complete the same CNA template. We will use this information in combination with our raw STAAR data to help us plan instructional goals for next year. We are also looking ahead to having some academic goal setting activities available to our students during technology classes next year. One of the components that we are missing this year is a level of academic maturity necessary for our students to perform at the level required of them to be successful on STAAR.

- 7. 6th graders are participating in the Fitness Frenzy through the Red Cross in their PE classes.
- 8. MISC Kids are attending a Leadership Summit at Prude Ranch March 30-31.
