SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of CSP 100114 for Child Nutrition Commodity Processing for the 2010-11 school year.

BOARD GOAL:

VI. Growth and Change...a. review and adjust policies and procedures effectively to address the challenges of rapid growth and changing demographic characteristics while maintaining and enhancing our strong sense of community

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

February 24, 2009 the Board approved the 2009-10 bid as recommended.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Bidders submit all of the services they provide. However, our district does not use all of the types of processing. The types used are noted on the summary sheets.

Proposals were submitted by Advance, Asian Food Services, Barrel O'Fun, Bosco's Pizza, Buena Vista Foods, Café Favorites, ConAgra Foods – Chuck Gentile, ConAgra Foods – Lamb Weston, Culinary Standards, DFM, East Side Entrees, Fieldale Farms, Good Harbor Fillet, House of Raeford Farms, J&J Snack Foods, JOY Foods, JR Simplot, JTM Provisions, Jennie-O Turkey, King's Delight, Land O'Lakes, Ling's, Lux Bakery, MCI Foods, McCain Foods USA, Maid-Rite Steak Company, Nardone Brothers Bakery, Pierre Foods, Pilgrim's Pride Corp, Red Gold, Rich Products, Schwan's, Trident Seafoods, Tabatchnick, Tyson, Viking Seafoods, and Wawona.

Pricing was submitted as a Fee for Service or Net off Invoice. It will depend upon the commodities actually processed as to how much will be spent.

Pricing was reviewed and each category of processing was given to the processor with the best over-all pricing.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Commodity Processing for the 2010-11 year must be approved by the end of February 2010.

The best over all pricing was submitted as follows;

Advance – Beef, Jennie-O – Turkey, Tyson Food – Chicken, ConAgra/Chuck Gentile – Mozzarella Cheese, JR Simplot – Potatoes, Land O'Lakes – Cheese.

An undetermined poundage of Tomato Paste may be processed through the Prospering Pals Cooperative to make up a full truck with Red Gold. No one school has enough paste to make a full truck.

Passage will allow the district to process the commodities it receives.
