


#### English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA 21) JULY 2025

- Assess and Track the progress of English Learners (ELs) as they develop their English Language skills.
- 4 Key Language Domains:
  - Listening
  - $\circ$  Reading
  - Speaking
  - Writing
- The Proficiency Levels are classified into 3 categories:
  - $\circ$  Emerging
  - $\circ$  Progressing
  - Proficient



### 2024-2025 Comparison

|             | 2023-2024 | 2023-2024<br>% of Recent<br>Arrivals | 2024-2025 | 2024-2025<br>% of Recent<br>Arrivals |
|-------------|-----------|--------------------------------------|-----------|--------------------------------------|
| EMERGING    | 401       | 44%                                  | 568       | 45%                                  |
| PROGRESSING | 1,898     | 5%                                   | 2,022     | 9%                                   |
| PROFICIENT  | 327       | 4%                                   | 367       | 5%                                   |

\*Recent Arrivals are students who arrived within the last 3 years.

- ELP Growth counts double on the state school report cards.


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# Accelerating English Language Proficiency
