These guidelines and procedures are subject to change based on positive cases, changes in guidance from MDH/MDE, or administrative discretion. The safety and health of staff and students is our top priority.

Therefore we will adjust our guidelines as necessary throughout the year. We will communicate all changes with our families promptly.

Masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks are not required for staff, students, or visitors inside of Lakeview Schools. • Students and staff are recommended to wear masks by the CDC and MDH.
Quarantine/ Contact Tracing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID 19, all family members will be sent home to quarantine immediately. They will need to quarantine for at least five days from the last exposure. No quarantine is necessary with proof of vaccination. • All non-family members will be notified that they have been exposed to COVID19. The family will decide if the child will quarantine or not. These days are considered excused absences. • We will handle remote learning (formally distance learning) on a case-by-case basis. Please contact Mr. Hanson for Grades 7-12 and Mrs. Frie for Grades K-6.
Handling of Positive Cases/ Symptomatic Persons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A student or staff member who tests positive will need to be quarantined for ten days from either start of symptoms or the positive test date (if asymptomatic). • Lab confirmed positive cases must be reported to the school. • A student or staff member presenting with symptoms consistent with COVID19 will be required to stay home for ten days from the start of symptoms. A negative COVID19 test can reduce this time.
Strategies to Reduce Risk of Transmission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • With the new upgrades of the air handling system, Lakeview Schools now uses a Bipolar Ionization filtration system. This technology utilizes specialized tubes that take oxygen molecules from the air and convert them into charged atoms that cluster

	<p>around microparticles, surrounding and deactivating harmful substances like airborne mold, bacteria, allergens, and viruses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classrooms will be provided with sanitizing surface solutions, and teachers will be required to wipe down all surfaces at least twice a day. ● Hand Sanitizing stations will still be available around the school for students, staff, and visitors to use. ● Students will be socially distanced when feasible, and seating charts will be followed.
Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Visitors are welcome to come to the building by appointment or notifying the classroom teacher you would like to visit. Visitors must check in with the office before going to classrooms. Masking is not required for visitors.
Lunch Procedures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Lunch procedures and offerings will be the same as they were in 2019-20. We will still follow the extra sanitation procedures put into place during the 20-21 school year.
Athletics and Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Athletics and Activity participants and coaches will follow the same rules as the school day. ● Some schools may have different guidelines when we attend away events. The staff and students of Lakeview will abide by the requests of the home school.
Busing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Under federal law, everyone on a school bus is required to wear a mask. Failure to do so could result in loss of bus privileges. ● Palmer Bus will develop seating charts for route buses. Failure to stay in the assigned seat could result in a loss of bus privileges.
