NEW GRANTS RECEIVED

- **Section 33 K-5 Visual Arts #6196: \$4,420**
Performance Period: 10.01.2025-09.30.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Averill
Purpose: These funds are for visual arts and music programs for schools that serve students in grades K-5.

- **CHUMS #8016: \$1,500**
Performance Period: 12.01.2025 – 06.30.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Everett
Purpose: Transportation to an art exhibit and supply money for Juneteenth art celebration event.

- **REO Olds Foundation #8256: \$15,000**
Performance Period: 12.14.2025 – 04.01.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Everett
Purpose: Grant funds were awarded to furnish the Everett student-led media center with audio, video and broadcasting equipment.

- **DAFT #8276: \$1,000**
Performance Period: 12.12.2025 – 06.30.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Everett
Purpose: Grant funds will be used to provide stipends for an Art Therapy Facilitator and for Student Mentor Drum leaders to support student social-emotional learning, creative expression, and mentorship through structure arts-based programming.

- **Dicks Sporting Goods #8416: \$25,000**
Performance Period: 01.01.2026 – 06.30.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Eastern Athletics
Purpose: Grant funds will be used to support athletic facility improvements, including the installation of a new softball batting cage with steel frame, structural repairs and upgrades to the baseball press box, and the purchase of a new basketball scorer's table to enhance safety, functionality, and student-athlete experience.

- **Run, Hide, Fight #8546: \$1,000**
Performance Period: 12.15.2025 – 06.01.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Everett
Purpose: Refreshments and stipends for two student assistants and two Teacher Mentors to facilitate PBS event.

- **Youth in Government #8716: \$1,000**
Performance Period: 12.01.2025 – 06.30.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Eastern
Purpose: Grant funds will support student participation in government simulation programs that build civic knowledge, leadership, and lifelong skills for responsible citizenship.

- **27L(2) Educator Compensation #6285: \$1,420,912.02**
Performance Period: 10.01.2025 – 09.30.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Educators District Wide
Purpose: Section 27l(2) funding is intended to support increases in educator compensation, allocated equally on a per-pupil basis and used to directly boost educator pay above and beyond existing negotiated compensation.

- **27M(2) National Board #6316: \$19,125**
Performance Period: 10.01.2025 – 09.30.2026
Carryover Allowed: No
Schools/Programs: Teachers pursuing National Board Certification
Purpose: To support teachers in Title I schools pursuing National Board Certification for the first time.
