Education Academy

The BISD Education Academy would be a partnership between AC Jones High School and a four-year university. This program would be specifically designed for ninth grade students interested in pursuing a future in public education. Beginning in the 10th grade, students will follow a cohort of classes that would yield up to 50 college hours while still in high school. High school graduates that successfully complete this program would be admitted into the partnering university and into their university Teacher Preparation Program.

Medical Professions Program

An exclusive partnership between a two or four-college and our ACJ Health Professions Magnet Academy (HPMA) for students interested in the medical profession. Our program would allow ACJ students the opportunity to earn 48 college credit hours at a partnering college while meeting high school graduation requirements. The students would also earn up to two industry certifications through this particular program.

Criminology Program

BISD would collaborate with a four-year university to offer field specific courses in the area of criminal justice to BISD seniors. These courses would be held outside of the school day or during the summer at the partnering campus.
