 - * Project Summary This project can be used for years to come to help support the content that teachers teach in their classrooms. We are limited in the places we can take our students, but it would be incredible to be able to find or create contact that will take students to the places being studied, while still being in the classroom. Virtual and Augmented Reality makes learning and understanding come alive in a way that is usually impossible. In time students can also create their own virtual experiences in order to immerse other students in their learning.

The idea behind the project comes from our mission as a school to provide new and unique learning experiences for our students. This project will be a boiler plate for related projects to come!

 - * Students Served 200
 - * Target Population The project will minimally serve multiple classrooms, but can potentially be used for the entire school population on a check-out process. Our goal is to have enough for whole classrooms to check out in order to use, and to keep them in a central location.
 - * Educational Need Hands-on experiences bring learning to a new level, and going on field trips can make learning come alive. However, classrooms are limited in the locations that we can take our students. Using virtual reality/augmented reality will give our teachers and students a new tool for learning. The barriers created when we study locations that are out of reach, can suddenly be broken. Teachers and students can create their own content as they travel to share with the class, and this will help connect the community to our classrooms as well.

 Students who have trouble with envisioning the content with only a few pictures and some words will have a chance to have the information take on new meaning. Beyond seeing the location, students wi

have a chance to have the information take on new meaning. Beyond seeing the location, students will create a memory with the content that may have otherwise been meaningless. We as teachers would like to work beyond students memorizing information temporarily. We want students to make connections and authentic memories with learning in order to engage them. STEM takes many forms, and virtual reality is a new way for students to access and create content for learning. Learning doesn't have to end with the tool, but can rather be a starting point for a new learning adventure

* Student Impact

Students will be engaged in the content that they are studying. Through the use of virtual reality, students will be able to develop their own questions that reach beyond surface level content. By being immersed into the information/location students will be able to explore on their own, and not be limited to a text or photo. The use of the technology will allow students to develop new ideas about how they may have solved a problem, or how they could solve a current problem. Students can present ideas to students in a new way that can create a stronger collaborative community. When learning comes alive it creates an opportunity for students to take ownership of their learning.

Our school is a STEM school, and the curriculum that we use teaches students to code, and this project would be a great extension for those students ready to take their learning to a new level. The project will also create great partnerships across grade levels because older/more experienced students can help create content for younger students. Honestly, the impact is only limited by the constraints the user places upon. Students are incredible, and can accomplish goals beyond our
