
October 2024 Special Education Board Report:

Our current consortium special education child count is currently 581 students that are on IEPs or are eligible

and are doing a transfer IEP from another district. We have another 14 students in the assessment process and 8 in referral. If all those students are eligible for services we will be 603 students on IEPs. Since adopting EdPlan as the consortium's IEP software we have either created an IEP, tested, exited, or graduated 712 students across the districts.

Upcoming PD:

Our next PD for teachers will be held **October 25th 2024**. Some the topics teachers have asked for are: Skill areas addressed by IEPs Help identifying appropriate accommodations Practice with giving Achievement Standardized Assessments
Picture Exchange Communication Systems
Difficult Students



We plan to try to try to incorporate as much of these as possible in the next PD session, including more time for them to collaborate at grade levels across districts to get ideas as this was also requested to help support each other in the classroom.


CPI Training


Survey Results from September 27th Professional Development Day:


Overall, how satisfied are you with the topics/materials covered during Professional Development? 10 responses




How useful did you find the different breakout sessions in relation to your role? 10 responses
