- ❖ 21st Century 4 different partners IRVAC/Siskiyou Health Center/College Dreams/IVHS- This is our final year of 100% funding - we risk losing grant if we can't get our attendance numbers up.
 - ➤ First 3 years to get everything set up and in motion. After that the funding decreases each year.
 - > Looking to come up with community activities to expand attendance.
 - ➤ Co-coordinator position posted, Scott Thornhill will now work at LBMS and work as a 21st Century PR person.

- Mr. Ongman suggests a possible hybrid program allowing more attendance to more classes. Possibly split days classes are offered for greater attendance.
- District Goals: Improve graduation rates
- Building Goals make sure students are on track to graduate must have 6 or more credits each year. We want to concentrate on our sophomores. Juniors and seniors need to be proactive.
