SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Netsync Network Solutions in the amount of \$1,225,323.90 for the purchase of the technology infrastructure for the new Denton High School campus.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management - Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This equipment provides the networking electronics, including switches, wireless access points, and VoIP phone equipment for the campus.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

This technology equipment and installation will be purchased through two Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperatives (DIR & TIPS). This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by this project's 2018 Bond Authorization budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to bring the new Denton High School campus network infrastructure online.
