RE: FY 2018 Federal Funding Notification and Single Audit Responsibilities and Guidance Letter

As required by federal regulation 2 CFR 200, the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is require to provide the program name, description, federal agency, and dollar amount expended Mid-Valley Special Education Cooperative. Further, the regulation requires subrecipients of federal funds (MVSEC) conduct a 'single audit" if we expend \$785,000 or more in federal awards during the fiscal year.
