The College and Career Academy at LaGrone Advanced Technology Complex Update

Board Goals:

Climate – Celebrate, respect and promote the values of diversity in our Denton ISD Community; and, encourage and nourish a safe learning and compassionate working environment which ensures open and transparent communication and is supportive, cooperative, and ethical; establish a high expectation level for success for all students, staff, parents, and community; instill in students a love of life-long learning; and, motivate and prepare students to embrace their full responsibilities and obligations as active citizens of their community, nation, and world..

Parent and Community Involvement – Foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students; utilize citizens' advisory committees to focus on short and long-term tasks; and, promote child advocacy across the state and nation.

Operational Impact:

As the Denton ISD remains committed to enriching teaching and learning experiences and increasing opportunities for students, program evaluation and funding sources will be a consideration as we look forward to opening the College and Career Academy. It is always a goal of the District to evaluate current structures and funding sources in a manner which may allow mitigation of any overall increase to cost; however, there may be staffing implications to consider. As staffing and programming are evaluated, we will provide more specific cost analysis during board workshops this spring.

Results:

Advantages:

Establishing a College and Career Academy provides a school of choice option for juniors and seniors who are focused on post-secondary readiness in a setting which allows students to pursue a college/career pathway with a strong academic core designed to support their aspirations.

Disadvantages:

Possible financial implications. However, increased participation in CTE programming may offset some of the anticipated expenses for establishing the College and Career Academy as a stand-alone campus.
