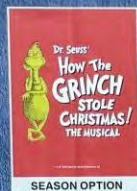

- MUHS had eight (8) Class of 2026 graduating seniors honored by the Yavapai Apache Nation









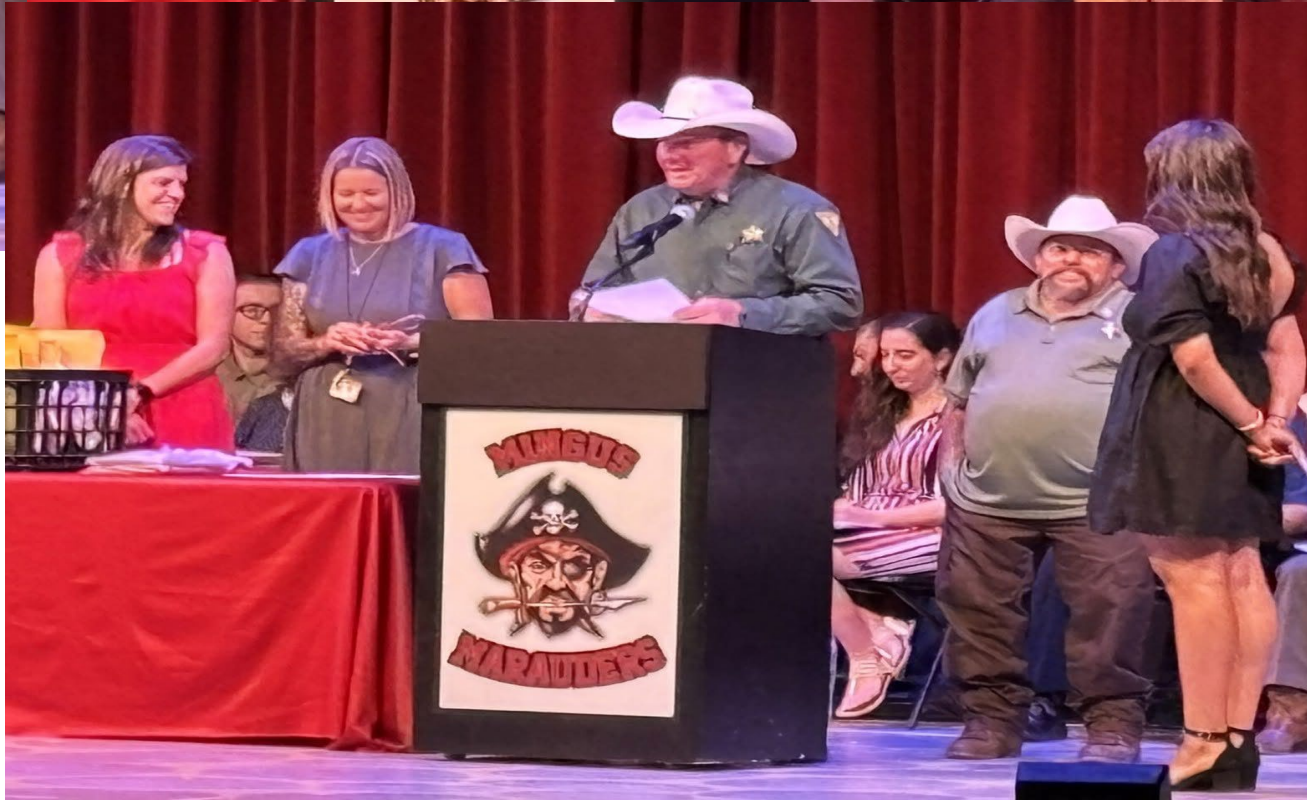

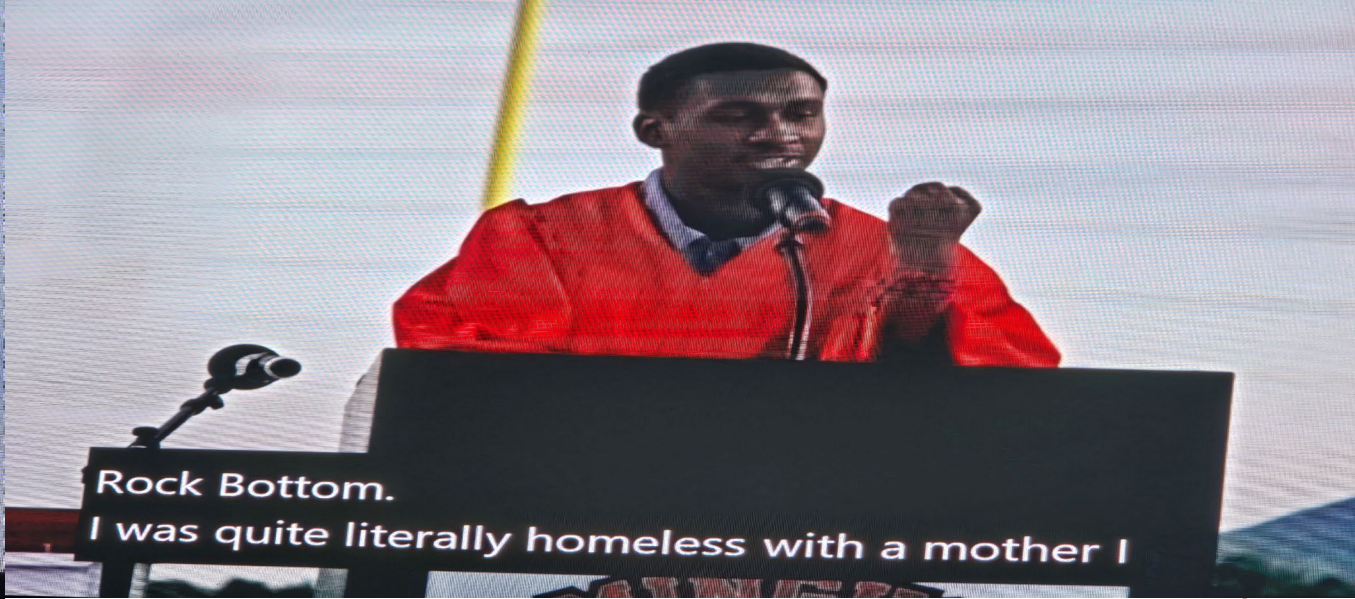
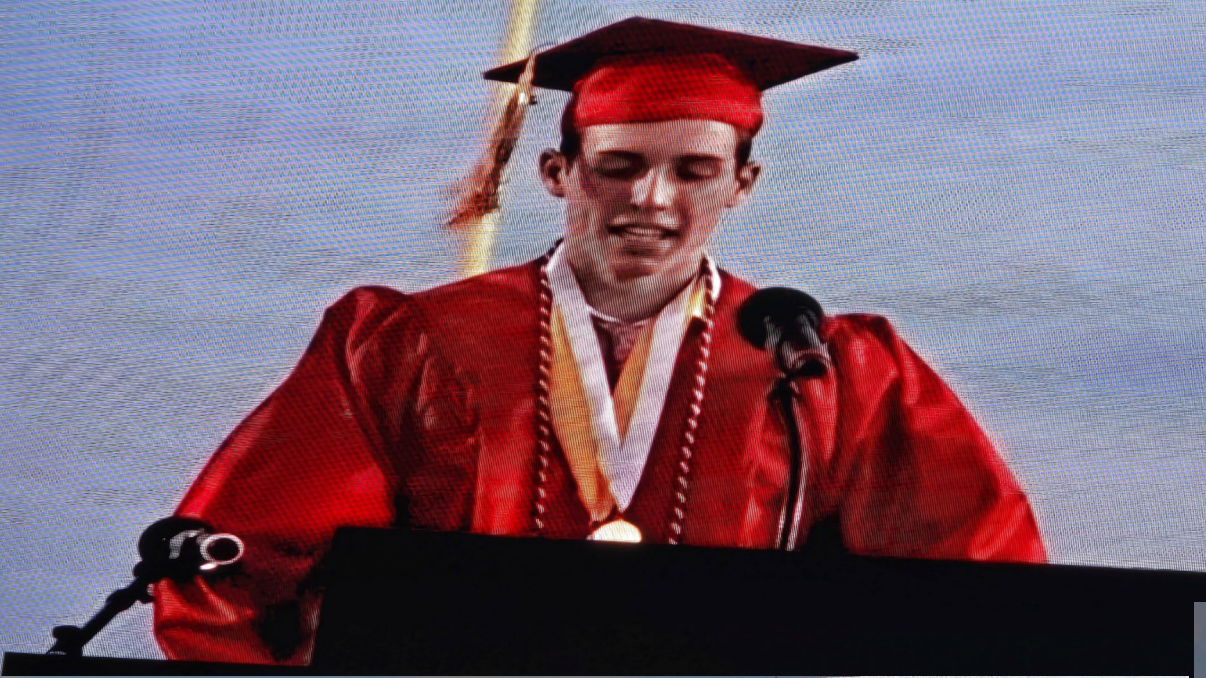
- Friday, May 26, 2026
