Discussion of TASB Board of Directors Nomination

Board Goal: Advocate for public education across the state and nation

Purpose of Report

The TASB Board of Directors is charged with carrying out directives established by the Delegates at the Delegate Assembly. The individual Director is expected to attend four Board meetings a year, with one of the meetings being at the same time as the annual TASA/TASB Convention. To nominate an individual the following forms must be completed: 1. Active member's nomination and candidate's willingness to serve 2. Candidate biographical sketch 3. Candidate questionnaire

- To submit a nominee from Denton ISD school board for the TASB Region 11, Position C seat.
- A TASB Director represents his or her region on the Board, guiding the organization to ensure that the Association fulfills its mission to provide advocacy, visionary leadership, and high-quality services.
