


## **FFA Degree Attainment**




#### **Degree Types**


- **Discovery Degree**: The first degree a member can earn for seventh or eighth grade
- **Greenhand Degree**: Awarded at the chapter level to ninth grade or older.
  - **Chapter Degree**: Awarded at the chapter level to 10th grade or higher.
- State Degree: Awarded by state associations to top members, usually earned during junior or senior year.
- American Degree: The highest FFA degree, awarded to an elite group of members at the national level, usually earned one year out of school.






