FROM THE PRINCIPAL


Dear Parents and Community Members,

This year, the state school report card has been redesigned to reflect results of the Smarter Balance Test (in its first year) as well as results in the OAKS Science test. 5th, 8th, and 10th grade students were given the following tests: English Language Arts (traditional test plus a performance task) Mathematics (traditional test plus a performance task) as well as OAKS Science. All grades 4-8, and 11th grade were tested. While we were not rated as a school this year, due to 2014-2015 being the initial year of the Smarter Balance test, all SJS scores exceeded the Oregon Performance percentage.

As a school, we are continuously developing and implementing programs to assist in our areas of difficulty, especially in 4th/5th reading and 4-6th mathematics.


