Request for Late Arrival, Early Dismissal, Or Release of Student for Part of the School Day

A request for late arrival, early dismissal or release of a student for part of the school day which

originates outside the schools must be handled by the administration to ensure maximum

provisions for the safety and welfare of the student. Late arrival, early dismissal, or release of

student for a part of the school day, should be requested only in emergency or unusual situations.

Parents requesting entrance after the beginning of the school day or dismissal before the normal

end of the school day or release of the student for part of the school day must make a written

request in advance to the building administrator and follow individual school procedures. If not

known in advance, the parent or guardian shall make the request in writing on that date and

receive permission from the principal for the student to enter class or to leave early. Discretion

shall be used by the principal to ensure the student's access to the educational program.

Students will not be authorized to arrive late, to be dismissed early, or to be excused from any

part of the regular school day for the purpose of taking regularly scheduled private lessons of any

kind or for activities of a recurring nature.

Released Time Provision Applicable to High School Students

The school day for all high school students will begin with the first period regular class and end

with the last period regular class. Exceptions will apply only for:

• students in an approved work-study program who must proceed to work

earlier in the day or remain at work later in the day, and

students who elect to take additional classes or credits and can provide their

own transportation.
