Re: Instructional Materials and Applications for Mathematics

The district determined there was a need for instructional materials and applications for mathematics. As a result, the district issued an RFP on May 9, 2022, to select a company to provide resources to support mathematics instructional design and learning. The district received five compliant responses.

The responses were evaluated based on the alignment to the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS), evidence of accessibility to all students, opportunities for student engagement in mathematics problem solving, evidence of customizable/editable format of resources, flexibility of professional development in a variety of formats including synchronous and asynchronous offerings, and supports for educators' understanding of teaching of mathematics. The resulting tabulation of those evaluations provided the following suppliers, in ranked order. Note: Package 1 was evaluated based on the following popular grade level bands amongst suppliers: K-5, 6-8, Algebra I.

District administration will attempt to negotiate a successful contract with the first ranked vendor, and if unsuccessful, we will move to the next ranked vendor.

The district administration intends to use ESSER funds to cover the cost of this service for at least the first year of the award.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approves the administration to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the recommended suppliers, renewed annually, not to exceed approximately \$341,000 annually, as long as the service continues to meet the needs of the District.
