The following changes are being recommended for the Saint Peter High School Student-Parent Handbook.

• Academics - Structured/Guided Study Hall

- o New Language
 - 1. Students are placed in a guided study hall for the following reasons:
 - a. Receiving a D- or below for a quarter or mid-quarter grade
 - b. Behavior referral
 - c. Poor attendance
 - 2. If a student is placed in a guided study hall at the beginning of the quarter, their progress will be reviewed at mid-quarter. If a student is placed in a guided study hall at mid-quarter, their progress will be reviewed at the end of the quarter.
 - 3. Guided study halls are to be quiet and conducive to study. Talking should be done quietly.
 - 4. Students are not allowed out of study hall.

• Attendance - Co-Curricular Participation

- o New Language
 - 1. In order to participate in co-curricular activities, students must be in attendance for the entire day, unless they have an excused absence listed in 2.C or approved by administration.
 - 2. If a student is suspended from any class, they may not participate in any activity or program that day.
 - 3. If a student is absent unexcused they may not participate in any activity or program that day.

Former Language

- 1. In order to participate in co-curricular activities, students must be in attendance for the entire day.

- 3. If a student is absent unexcused from any class, they may not participate in any activity or program that day.

• Technology - Cell Phone Use

- New Language
 - 1. Cell phones are not allowed in academic areas of St Peter High School.
 - a. Classrooms
 - b. Pods
 - c. Any area where academic instruction is taking place
 - 2. Cell phones may not be used in any manner that causes or results in disruption of the educational environment or school-sponsored extracurricular activities or events or impairs or interferes with school district operations.
 - 3. Students shall keep their personal electronic communication devices (cell phones) in a secure place, such as the student's locker, a closed backpack, a storage device provided by the school, or an area designated by the classroom teacher, at all times when personal electronic communication device use is prohibited.
 - 4. The school district is not responsible for, nor is it required to investigate, any lost, stolen, or damaged personal electronic communication devices brought onto school grounds, the bus, or school-sponsored activities or events.

- Former Language
 - 1. Cell phone use in the classroom will be allowed per teacher discretion. Teachers have posted their cell phone policies in the classroom.
- <u>Graduation Requirements</u> Changes in state testing requirements (if any) from the state of Minnesota will be reflected.
