  - a. St. Martian Jim Rothstein
    - i. ~\$5 million in commercial development
    - ii. No housing starts; city doesn't pursue
    - iii. Water & sewer project design in progress; planned for this summer currently planning on holding ponds
  - b. Avon Township John Merden
    - i. Fairly quiet overall
    - ii. Working with City of Avon on a possible fire board joint ownership arrangement, but nothing for sure
  - c. Krain Township Scott Laing
    - i. Building boom 5 new houses
  - d. Albany Township Diane Knoll
    - i. Spent the past several months working on rezoning around the city
    - ii. Transfer of Development Rights (TDR)
      - 1. A40 are really tough; trying to come up with a compromise
      - 2. Board has struggled with this for several months but starting to come together and reach some consensus
      - 3. Building has been down 1 new housing start
  - e. Farming Township Dan Stommes
    - i. Very quiet; no new building starts
  - f. City of Albany Daron Gersch
    - i. Whispering Oaks lots were foreclosed; acquired by state
      - 1. ~36-37 lots
      - 2. Auction will occur soon
      - 3. Minimal land costs and accrued property taxes (Very inexpensive \$6-10K and taxes \$10-12K)
    - ii. Fifth street improvement project (by clinic)
      - 1. Will divert water that normally flowed down and straight in North Lake and will add a retention pond near the clinic
