We are pleased to welcome Faith Bible Christian Academy as a member of the IHSA for the 2018-19 school term. Your enrollment for 2018-19 will be based on the IHSA's Classification Policy. As a member school, the administration and coaches at Faith Bible Christian Academy should familiarize yourself with the IHSA Schools Center. Please make sure to update school personnel information in the Schools Center since we often communicate with our member school principals, athletic directors and coaches through email. We appreciate your cooperation in seeing that the information is provided. The Schools Center is also the site where you enter your school in the different state final sports and activities.

As a member of the Illinois High School Association, By-law 2.130.1 requires each new member school principal, within the first two (2) years of becoming a principal, attend a workshop or view an online presentation developed for new administrators by the IHSA. Failure to comply with this requirement may be penalized by the Board of Directors. In addition, IHSA By-law 2.130 requires each member school principal or his/her designee shall be in attendance at an annual principals' rules meeting/town meeting conducted in November. A complete listing of the Town Meetings/Principals Rules Meetings can be found on the IHSA website. Also, please review the information provided regarding the Rocky Clark Catastrophic Insurance legislation in the State of Illinois which requires high schools in Illinois to provide catastrophic insurance coverage for students participating in IHSA sanctioned athletic events. Publications for the 2018-19 school term will be shipped the first week of August.
