INSTRUCTIONS FOR BI-ANNUAL CLEANLINESS INSPECTION

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this inspection is one part of the action plan to accomplish Strategic Goal #5 to provide a high-quality environment that is essential to the educational success of students. This inspection will determine the level of cleanliness at a school site and target areas that need improvement.

PROCESS:

Each site will be inspected quarterly. The inspections will be at random. The designee will conduct this inspection with the Site Administrator or designee. Each inspector will use the School Site Cleanliness Inspection Form.

The inspection will include but is not limited to the following:

- Outside Grounds
- o Buildings
- Main Entrance
- Hallways
- One set of Boys and Girls Restrooms
- Two Classrooms at random
- Cafeteria/Gym/Media Center
- Custodial Room
- o Supply Room

FOLLOW UP AND CORRECTION:

The Site Administrator and Designated Inspector will use this inspection to identify and correct deficiencies in site cleanliness. They will jointly address all deficiencies and design a plan for follow up, to ensure satisfactory corrections have been made.
