
OSBA BOARD NOMINATIONS

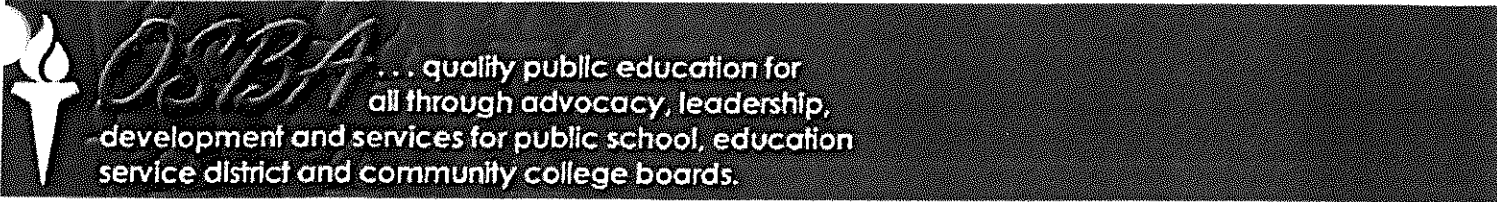
POLICY ISSUE / SITUATION:
