Subject: ASVAB Testing Sessions and Participation Update

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military. (<https://www.officialasvab.com/>)

The ASVAB is free to Judson ISD students and is given to 10-12 grade students on a sign-up basis at each of comprehensive high schools. JECA administers ASVAB to all Juniors through their College Prep teachers. Efforts are being made to increase opportunities with the number of sessions planned this year projected to be more than the number of sessions last year.
