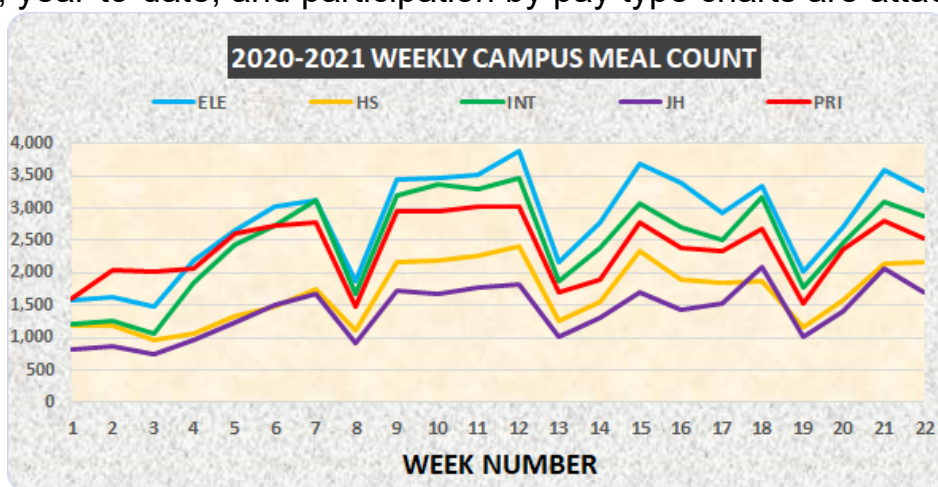

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Here's our weekly Meal Participation Report for **Week 22**, ended February 5, 2021. The trend line, year-to-date, and participation by pay type charts are attached.

This week, all campus meal counts were down with the exception of **HS**! Did everyone run over to the **HS** Gym foyer to see what it's like to eat there? What will they do when **HS** gets its new cafeteria?

Here's a snapshot: total meal count is down 7% from last year. BREAKFAST & LUNCH participation is down 5%. DINNER meal count is up 35%, thanks largely to **PRI, INT & ELE**! A special thanks to our staff involved in the Dinner program, which is really helping make up the decline in the other meals. This is a life-saver for the Food Nutrition department.

No change in any of the campus rankings this week. **ELE** leads in meal count, with **INT** and **PRI** nearly tied for 2nd place. **PRI** is still the only campus ahead of last year's meal count. BREAKFAST & LUNCH participation has **PRI** in the lead, followed by **ELE, JH** and **INT**.

This past week we learned that the Department of Agriculture is planning on reimbursing school districts for a portion of last spring's decline in food service revenues due to the COVID-19 pandemic. For GISD, this could mean that our fiscal 2020 Food Service loss of \$62,000 might be substantially recouped sometime in the second half of 2021. That would be great news!

This year we are required to submit our Food Service Management Company contract for bids. The District will soon be issuing Requests for Proposals (RFP) as a result. The process will go through April when the board meets to approve a new contract.

Our thanks to the GISD cafeteria staff and our Sodexo partners for serving the nutrition needs of our students!

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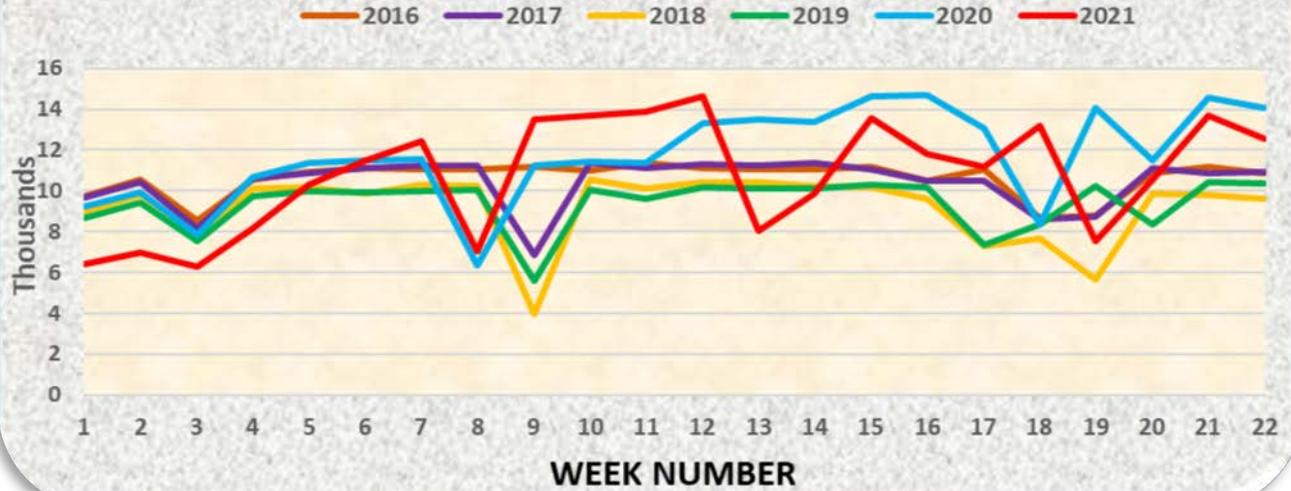
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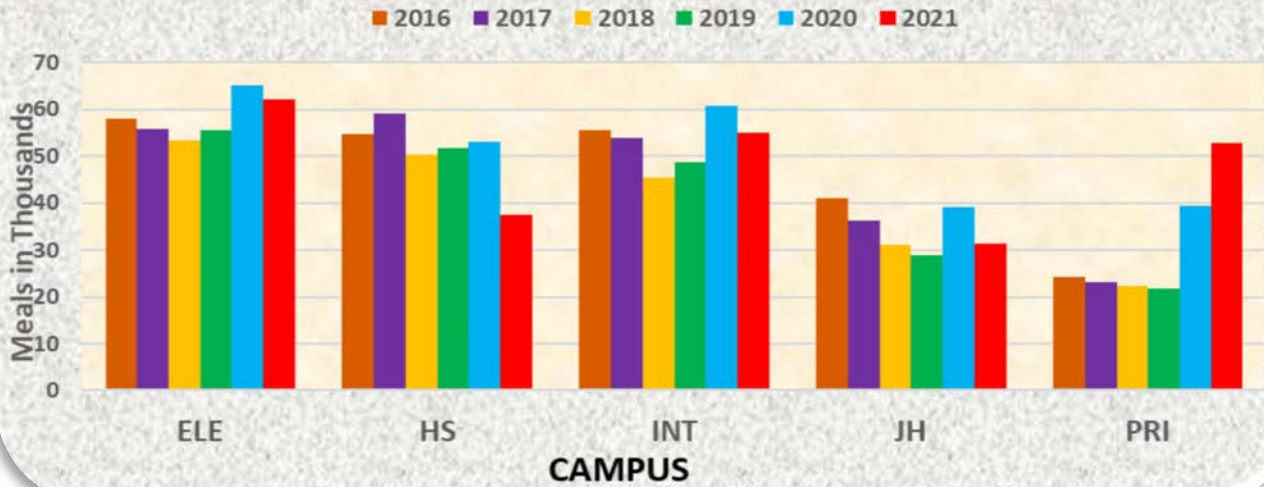

2016-2021 DISTRICT-WIDE WEEKLY MEAL COUNT

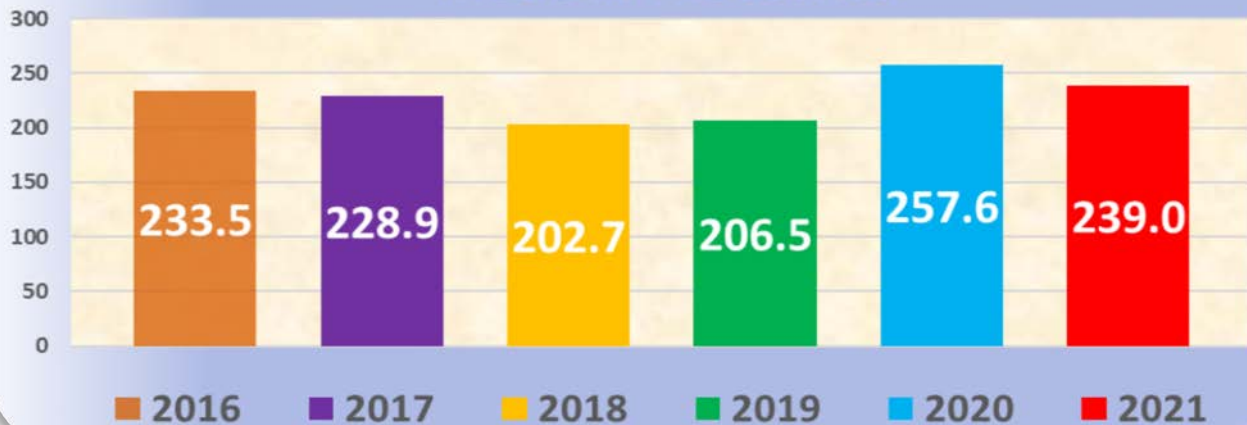


2016-2021 CUMULATIVE MEAL COUNT THROUGH WEEK 22

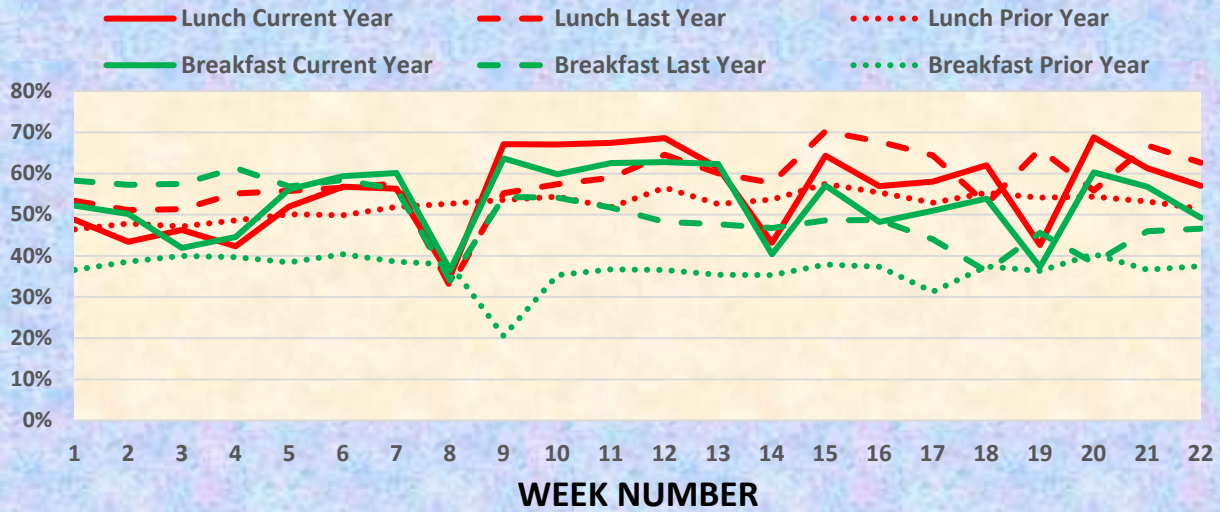

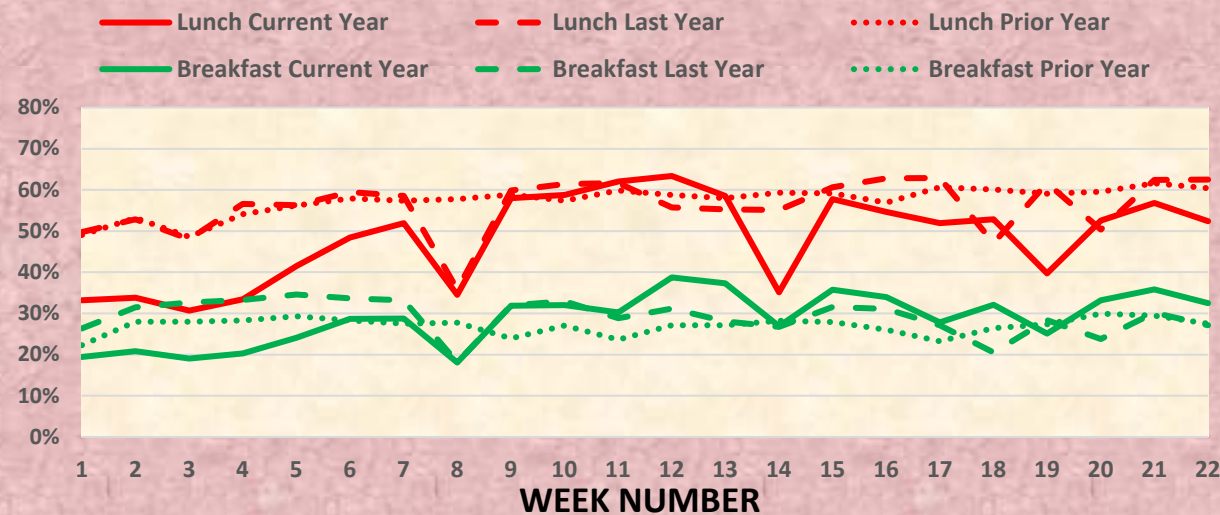

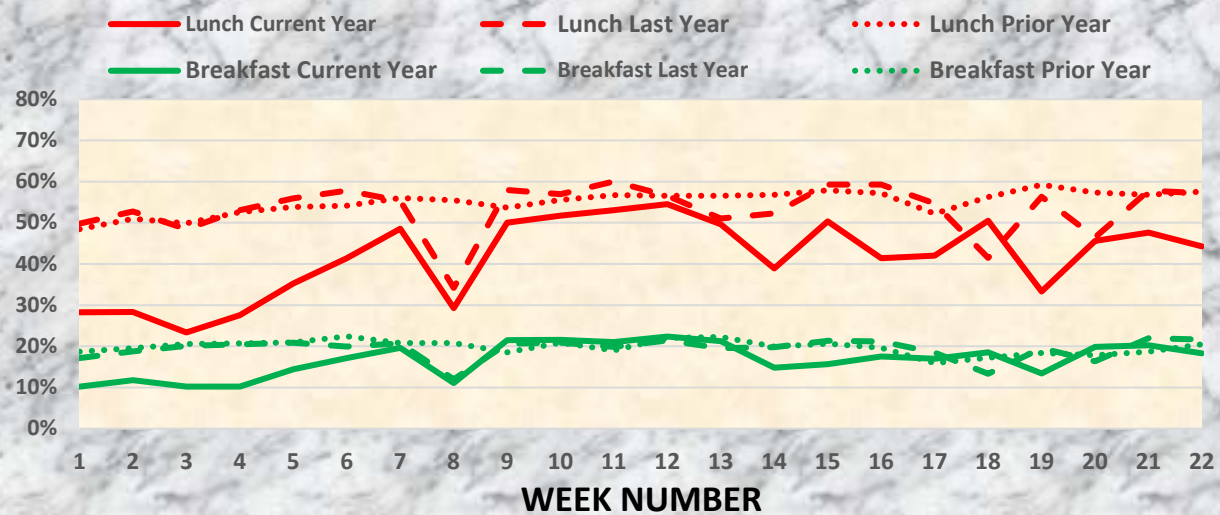
2020-2021 PRIMARY MEAL PARTICIPATION



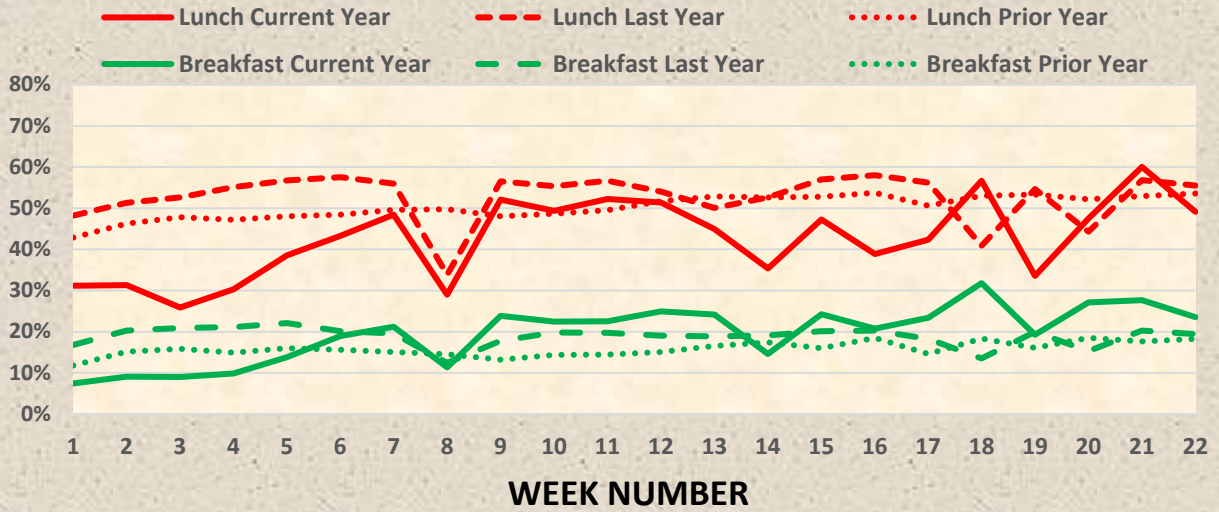
2020-2021 ELEMENTARY MEAL PARTICIPATION



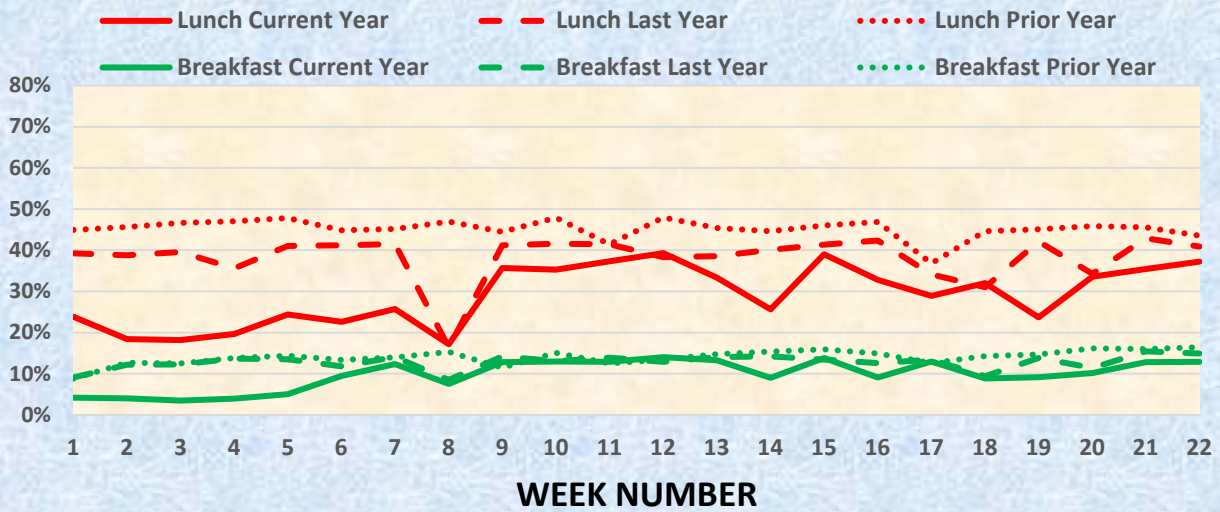
2020-2021 INTERMEDIATE MEAL PARTICIPATION



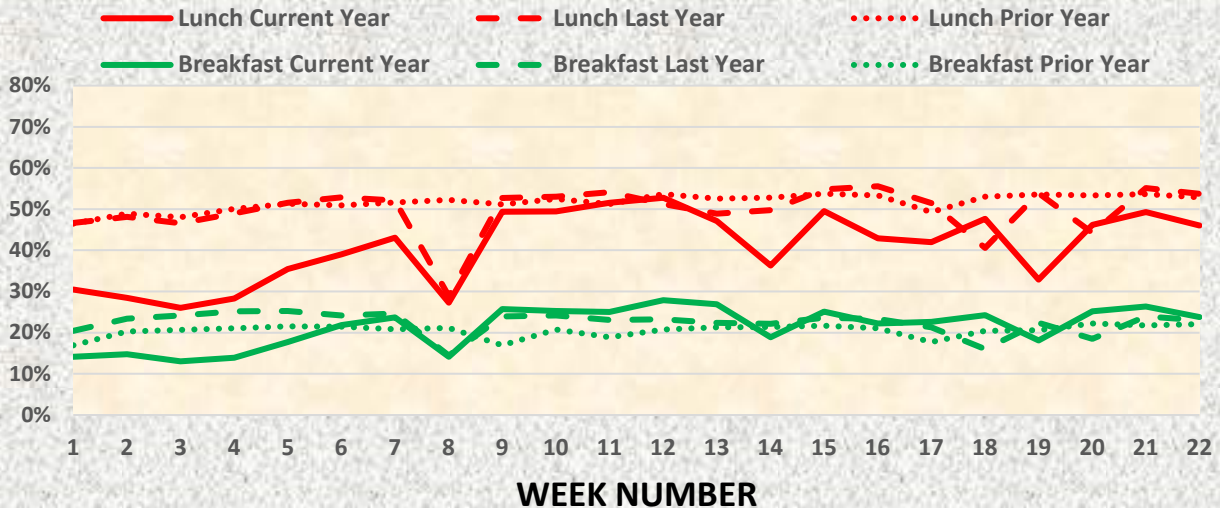
2020-2021 JUNIOR HIGH MEAL PARTICIPATION



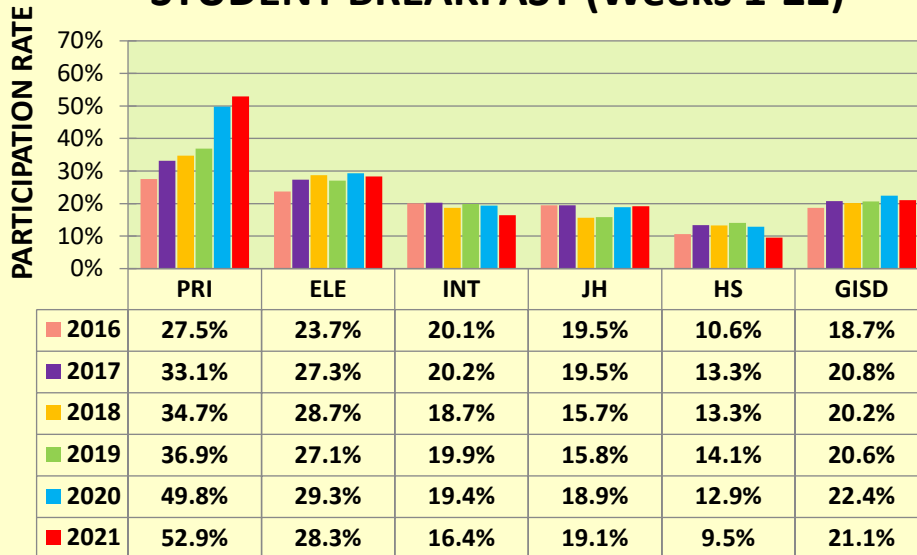
2020-2021 HIGH SCHOOL MEAL PARTICIPATION



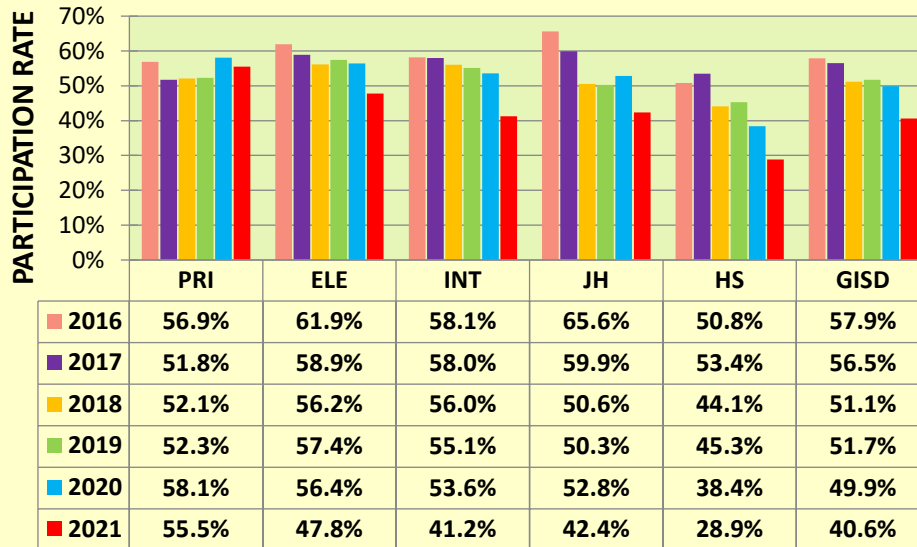

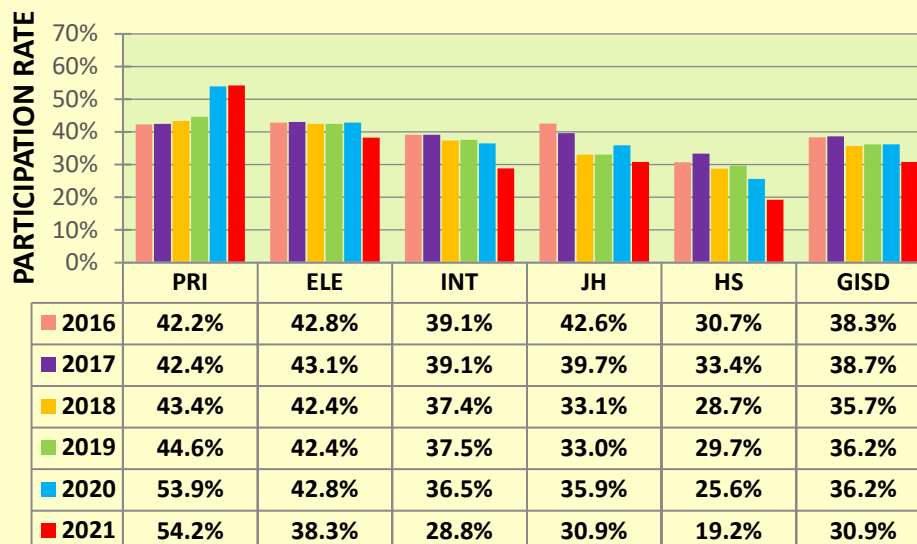
STUDENT BREAKFAST (Weeks 1-22)
