## Background Information:

Navarro ISD has experienced a steady increase in enrollment within our Emergent Bilingual (EB) program. We have now reached the state-mandated threshold of 20 or more Emergent Bilingual students in a single grade level, triggering the requirement to implement a bilingual education program in accordance with TEA regulations. In anticipation of this growth, the district leadership team has proactively begun preparing for this transition. For the 2025–2026 school year, Navarro ISD will apply for a bilingual program exception waiver. During this time, we will focus on recruiting qualified staff and laying the groundwork to fully implement a compliant bilingual program for the 2026–2027 school year.
