TPSD Strategic Planning Survey

Executive Summary

Four questions in the 2008 TPSD Strategic Planning Survey gave respondents the opportunity to write in their own ideas and comments. Respondents took the survey in the nine day period between Thursday, February 28, 2008 and Friday, March 7, 2008. 320 parents, 48 community members, and 286 employees answered the survey questions. A total of 657 respondents answered the questions with multiple ideas and recommendations. We classified the open ended responses into response categories and in some cases, subcategories to gain a picture of the frequency of responses. Lists of specific responses are located in the appendixes. In Appendix A (pg. 4), you can read the responses for question one exactly as we received them. Appendix B (pg. 21) contains the answers to question two, Appendix C (pg. 39) question three, and Appendix D (Pg. 68) question four.
